

How to access Patient Keeper on Android devices

1. Go to **Settings**, tap into the **Search** field at the top of the screen and search for **Install unknown** apps.





3. From the list of apps, select the Internet browser that you use (for example, Chrome). Turn on the **Allow from this source** option



- 4. Open the **Chrome** browser app on your device and access the web address <u>https://sunyds.patientkeeper.com/ota</u> for installing the PatientKeeper app
- 5. Once the web address is entered, the **Patient Keeper APK** file will start to download. The **APK** file can also be found in the **Notification Center**. Click **Open** when download is complete.





6. Click Install



7. Once installed, open application



8. Enter Host Field as: **Sunyds.patientkeeper.com** and enter your **NetID** in the **Username** Field and **Password** Field then tap **Login.** (The **Host** field is a onetime input)

- 10. For Notification setup
 - 1. Go to the ${\ensuremath{\textbf{Settings}}}$ app
 - 2. Tap on Notification
 - 3. Tap on More
 - 4. Turn **On** notification for **PatientKeeper**
