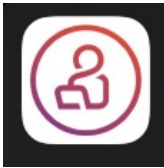


## How to access Patient Keeper on IOS devices

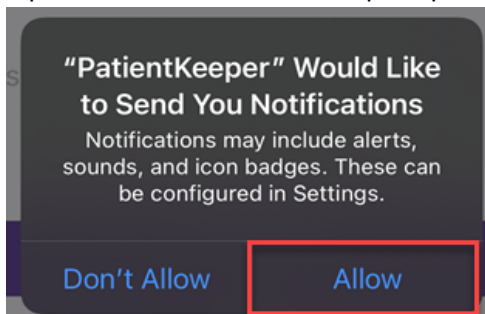

1. Go to the Apple App Store app.
2. Search for **Patient Keeper**
3. Select and install the app "**PatientKeeper**" not "PK8"



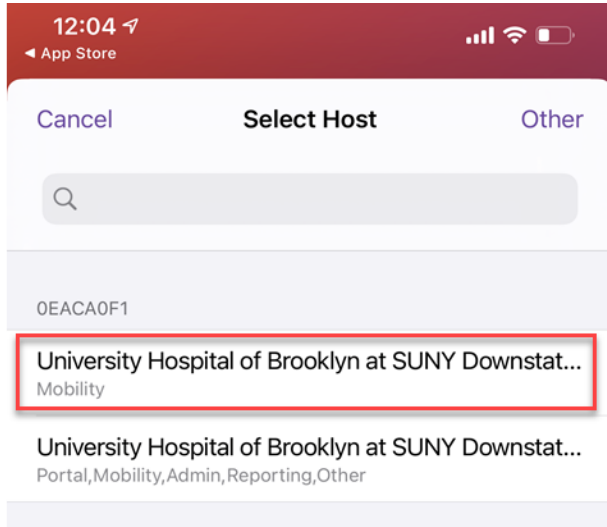
4. Once installed, open application
5. Tap **Allow** for the **Notification** prompt.



6. Enter your **NetID** in the **Username** Field and **Password** Field then tap **Login**.
