



Stop Selecting Old ICD-9 codes!

❖ **STOP** - *Do not select ICD-9 codes from previous visits*

You must only select the NEW ICD-10 codes. You can verify this by the Coding Scheme and the Code Column, they determines how a code was entered. **Do not select** the Coding Scheme that reflects the **old ICD-9 codes.**

FACTS:

- ❑ The Coding Scheme column notifies you if an entry was submitted as an Old ICD-9 or a New ICD-10 code.
- ❑ You must enter all Outpatient codes as **OP Primary Dx** and **OP Secondary Dx**.

Steps for removing ICD-9 codes from your favorites

- ❖ Click on the "Preferences" button in the "Main" toolbar, then click Health Issues.
- ❖ Select all ICD-9 codes you wish to remove.
- ❖ Next, click the "Remove" link.
