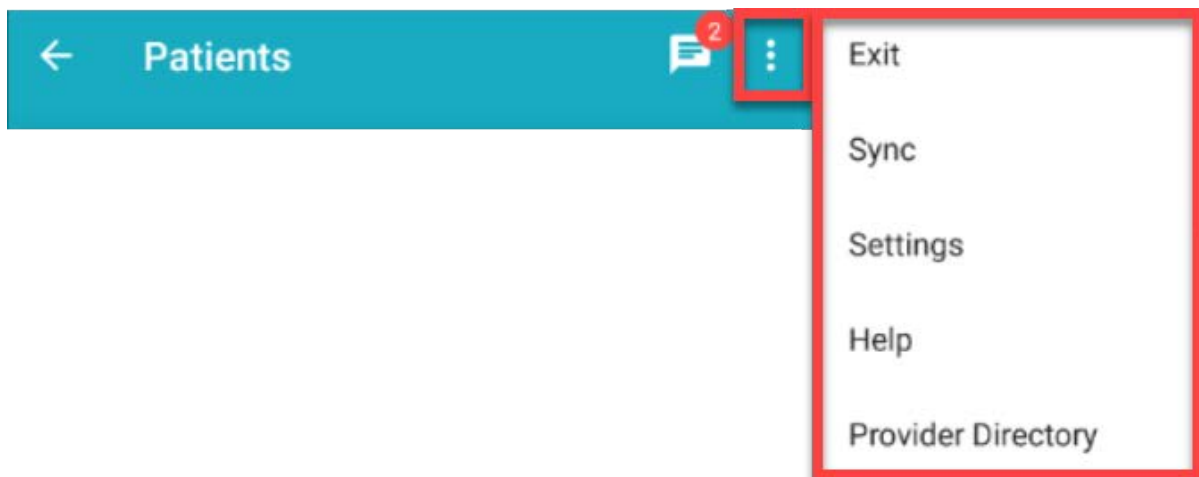

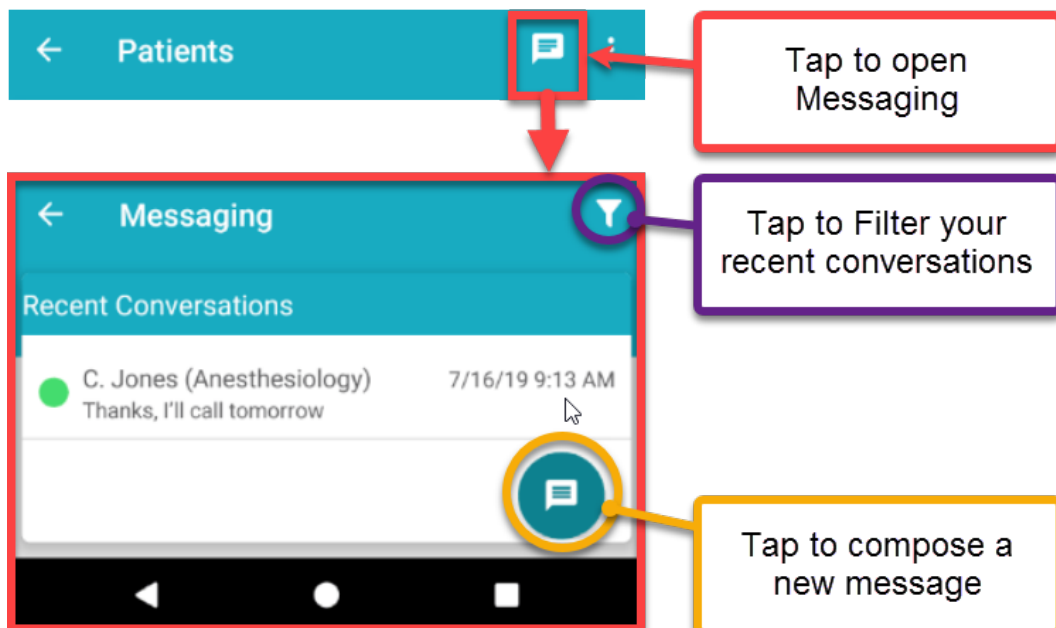
More Menu icon

At the top right of the screen, you have the **More Menu** icon. The options will change depending on the module currently selected




Messages Icon

Patient List


When logged in, the patient List is shown. You will be able to create and share your own list, find and favorite another provider's patient list.
