


## PatientKeeper Quick guide for iOS devices

### Patients Tab

When logged in, the patient List is shown. You will be able to create and share your own list, find and favorite another provider's patient list.





Allows you to send secure messages between providers and receive valuable information about your patients









## Sign-Out

The **PatientKeeper Sign-Out Summary** allows providers to view **Sign-Out** notes and tasks for all **patients** on a specific **patient** list. Choose a **patient** and then tap on **Sign-Out** to open the **Sign-Out** module for editing.
