The City issued temporary COVID-19 Medical Health On-Street Parking Permits to health care workers in hospitals and medical facilities throughout the five boroughs. Each hospital received a set number of permits in Spring 2021 (*at Downstate, they were issued by Hospital Administration through hospital department heads/administrators*).

New permits are no longer being issued, but replacement permits are being issued to accommodate a vehicle change, or if the permit has been reported lost or stolen.

This permit is valid citywide and should only be used for medical employment purposes. Please note that all parts of the COVID-19 permit must be properly completed for it to be valid. Vehicles displaying permits with missing information may be ticketed.
