Senators were instructed by SUNY Central to get feedback on our reaction to their recent resolutions:

- (1) Regarding eliminating a required standardized admission test for SUNY Schools (excluding medical and law schools) the feeling among those in the room who are affiliated with PH, CHRP PT, or SGS was that the GRE is a useful and informative assessment, but that others in these schools should be surveyed as well
- (2) Regarding reinstatement of Graduate Incentive Program unanimously supported
- (3) Regarding provision of adequate lactation spaces unanimously supported
- (4) Regarding use of gender-neutral language in official documents from SUNY Central, Chancellor's office, and SUNY Administration support the spirit of the rule, but controversy of the specific substitute language to be used ("Theirs") 11 in favor, 5 abstain due to language/grammar issues
