Senators were instructed by SUNY Central to get feedback on our reaction to their recent resolutions:

- (1) Regarding eliminating a required standardized admission test for SUNY Schools (excluding medical and law schools) - the feeling among those in the room who are affiliated with PH, CHRP PT, or SGS was that the GRE is a useful and informative assessment, but that others in these schools should be surveyed as well
- (2) Regarding reinstatement of Graduate Incentive Program – unanimously supported
- (3) Regarding provision of adequate lactation spaces – unanimously supported
- (4) Regarding use of gender-neutral language in official documents from SUNY Central, Chancellor’s office, and SUNY Administration – support the spirit of the rule, but controversy of the specific substitute language to be used (“Theirs”) – 11 in favor, 5 abstain due to language/grammar issues
