Presiding Officer Reports

New members introduced themselves.

Dr. Viswanathan discussed the appeal polices of CAPQ.

Center-Wide Committee

Dr. Persaud reported the colleges had concerns with the website not being updated. The College of Nursing discusses their concerns regarding admission.

Sub-committee Reports

CEPC

Dr. Nowakowsi reported that the committee held its first meeting of this academic year on September 14th, 2021. In the previous meeting. It was discussed that CEPC was trying to seek financial support for medical students interested in Research. The Alumni Association Association responded with a possibility of considering individual applications for support from them.

Dr. Nowakowsi spoke to Dr. Lazar and was told that the college is under pressure for financial cuts across the board. Dr. Nowakowsi discussed this with Dr. Shirley Eisner, who is very involved with the medical education pathway. She suggested that she recommend one or more students as a work-study project to help produce a comprehensive list of potential members.

There is a new SVPR, new initiatives, and a new research strategy for the school. The Research, Resource, and Budget committee will address these issues once the committee meets.
