Trending Topics

- 1.) New dean and MedCouncil member introductions
 - a. Appointing Jane Kim to oversee Sim Center, will be expanded as well moving forward
 - b. 3 initiatives focusing on: (1) professionalism (kindness, compassion over command, control, fear, intimidation for training), (2) diversity and inclusion (gender, race), (3) wellness and resilience (critically important that this is addressed, need to learn to manage our stress in medicine)

2.) Wellness

- a. 2nd years studying in library and Dr. Brevel gave out treats, really sweet
- b. Dr. Marquel shared thinking of tearing down interlab area on 5^{th} floor > survey for 2^{nd} years about putting lounge there for students
 - i. Concern with 5^{th} floor carrels being study spot that it could be distracting if loud, not best location
 - ii. Brought up by LCME survey that more study spaces would be ideal
- c. Goal was to start MC sponsored wellness events, hasn't happened yet
 - i. Jordana talking to Adam about yoga
 - ii. Next meeting each bring an idea for a fun, engaging wellness event
 - 1. Aaron Huang organized some events for 2022: rock-climbing, Botanical Gardens, poorly attended but solid effort
 - iii. Big struggle with lack of consistency and structure in day
 - 1. Consistent and FREE event would be ideal yoga every 2 weeks
 - 2. People don't want to pay for mini-courses, also not ideal timing

3.) Step 1 Pass/Fail

- a. Would like to get some sort of update from admin as it becomes available
 - i. Didn't expect this decision to be made so fast, now doing recon
 - ii. Questions about people in MD/PhD and people considering a gap year and about what this will mean for Step 2
 - iii. Email has gone out from Dr. Putnam to MS1 and 2 classes and invited students to send in questions
 - iv. Will send out any updates as they become available
- Discussion of moving Step 1 to end of third year but now would mean it would be P/F for current first years, no answers yet, need to talk to residency programs, ongoing conversation
 - i. Meeting next month with residency programs where more info may be available
 - ii. Issue is may be better for some people to take it graded and for others to wait
 - iii. Also, what does it mean if you don't have that six-week break? Do you start clinicals in February, then not enough space, three classes in clinical sites at same time?

4.) Student Activities Referendum

- a. Need to have student activities fee to continue all activities of student clubs, organizations, food at events, yearbook, intramural sports, orientation, mini-courses, gym, movie nights, coffee houses, thanksgiving dinner, etc.
- b. Vote on whether to make student activity fee mandatory, every four years we vote to continue to have activity fee and then every student has to pay it, if vote fails then becomes voluntary and can't pay for important initiatives
 - i. Being emailed on March 30th
 - ii. Encourage class members to vote in favor because we want to continue to have student services and extracurriculars

- iii. Not vote to save \$200 a year, vote to keep the student life program alive!
