- d. Building the Next Generation of Academic Physicians Alexandra Belzie
 - Fall speaker meeting 12/4
 - 1. \$100 for four \$25 Amazon gift cards for participation
 - 2. Brand-new club, want to encourage participation in first meeting, Dr. Sola will be speaking, incentive people to come with gift cards
 - a. Dr. Sola is previously affiliated with Downstate, may still be or be again soon, would be legally not allowed
 - 3. New club so can vote to give \$250 discretionary \$
 - 4. Asked if since raffles not allowed can do gift for speaker
 - ii. Conference Jan 8-9
 - 1. Requesting 1725: 1200 food, 300 paraphernalia, 225 for gifts for 5 speakers
 - 2. Looking for other funding sources and for suggestions on funding sources
 - Still can't have in person events, unclear if will be allowed in January, for now may need to put on hold and ask club to return at a future meetings
 - 4. Ask national org if any funding/grants for a conference
 - 5. Paraphernalia and speakers guaranteed
 - 6. Org for future physicians so not likely to receive funding from UC
- 3. Update: clubs can buy gifts outside bookstore AND can request honorariums for speakers with a suggested cap of \$300 from MC and \$100 from UC
 - a. No state employee including SUNY Downstate staff/faculty can be paid
 - b. Determined on a case by case basis
 - This means clubs should present and request to have honorarium for speaker so we can determine it is someone who provides expertise outside of DS
 - c. Will also allow gifts from outside bookstore, \$45 cap
- 4. Testing and temperature checks for in-person students?
 - a. Not really accurate, doing it ourselves
- 5. Wifi question current dorm wifi is not reliable
 - a. Can students request on-campus space for exams or is there a plan to improve wifi?

- b. Big issue during classes, dropping out multiple times, BB collaborate can tell who is in dorm bc red battery with 0 bit rate, sound and video skipping, panopto too not even just in live classes
- c. Harder to participate be own voice lagging and feed lagging, images not sharp for histology and anatomy
- d. Ends of halls farthest from elevator worse, people find wifi from another building better than dorm wifi while there
- e. Putman: working on two options right now, one being getting cable company to finalize improvements and two being allowing you to come on campus for exams
 - i. Tell people to email help desk and say "this is where I am, this is problem I'm having" > put new sensors
- f. April is going to email blast her class to send info and CC Putman
- g. Brunicardi: analyzing GQ and ISA, working on issues, had LCME mock site visit this week, general theme was that Downstate admits and trains outstanding young doctors, they were very impressed by you all

 - Motions from past off-set, no sense of when we should be hearing back from department chairs, having a clear date/timeline would be very reassuring, not getting info last min
 - Some clinical deans don't seem to have MSPE info and it's a month from due date

- Putman is doing some digging to get answers for process and dates for 2021
- Next week more info on reserving spaces for doing interviews on campus, unclear right now though what other unis are doing (full-day program vs short interview, meeting, Q&A virtually)
 - Only reserve once you are invited for an interview, have to show confirmation
- Clear updated graduation requirements
 - Can we get an updated list of requirements changed, as discussed in TH?
- AOA Notifications
- Ouartiles
- Will touch base with class, work to set up answers and TH with Brunicardi

B. 2022

- Finished first shelf, some people have gotten grades
- Tx to new clerkship, King's County still hard to get ID and EPIC access, Shaundra Williams really helpful but shouldn't be this hard
- Year-long clearance for students possible? can go to HR and ask to extend it
- Brookdale shuttle service extension being discussed, shuttles very helpful
- Library hours only opened until 5 PM, plans to extend hours?
 - Yes, being discussed BUT 395 entrance closed and staff gone after 5, working to extend hours at least on 1st floor shortly
 - Other piece is talking to VP for operations talking about other spaces for students to study late hours, solution soon
 - Scanner will be installed at 395 eventually and will be available as entry again, need someone to do screening though, issue isn't guard, has to be a healthcare person, working on a system
 - Also discussion about relaxation space for future? LCME requirement so it is still a priority, space selected as a meditation room but can't open these spaces until COVID rules lifted
 - Tennis courts open but gym still closed, can't borrow equipment
 - We have minimized exposures, need to maintain safety, avoid outbreak like other SUNYs

C. 2023

- Any updates for Unit 6 plan? optional to return, what will be in person...
 - Bringing us back early Nov, OEDLT working out these details
 - o 25% of class is not in commuting distance currently
 - Keeping in mind we would be back for Unit 6 and then off for dedicated, we really want this to be a clearly communicated and informed decision
 - Also curious what it is we will be doing in person, if it's just PBL what is the benefit-risk ratio
 - Possibility of transitional period where people can do 7 day quarantine and then start unit 6 in second week or so
 - o Planning to move to hybrid still, optimize model
 - o Thanksgiving and christmas unit 6, then what do we do for holidays?
 - Concern students may travel, come back and not quarantine

- Not clear what will be in person, time for another TH
- If anyone is legitimately immunocompromised they will be able to submit proof/doctor's note and work with admin to figure out how to proceed
- Step decision option to delay to 3rd year?
- Lecture quality up and rerecordings greatly appreciated!
- SPs said disrespectful things about students, recorded on gateway videos
 - Email sent to faculty but no response over past two weeks
 - Even for students who may have struggled, this is our first attempt at this and it's not appropriate and disheartening to hear these comments. It also implies biased mentality for students they are grading
 - Can we re-examine the videos that were inappropriate to see if anyone who failed Gateway had an unfair eval? - Dr. Putman will review and make sure this is done
 - Not just about grades, those SPs should be reprimanded, dismissed if they did let it influence grading

D. 2024

 - No info shared as of today, class feels like no clue what's happening
 - o Dr. Grannat is working on this, should be out in a day or so
- Polled class asking for MCQs for anatomy as preference, 92.4% prefer MCQs
