Old business:

- Daniel makes the motion to accept last meeting minutes, Kumar seconds. Motion passes

 - The invoice we were given isn't clear, there's no specific prices on anything

 - Crash course for x-ray interpretation and EKG information

 - Believes posters will be done in April
 - There's another event called Rising Stars that students are selected by professors (maybe 10 students)
 - We would like the students to come in that are asking for money so we know exactly what the money is going to and then we can determine our budget vs their needs

New business

- Special Olympics:

- Summer internship at Bellevue: shadow a nurse where ever you want to, 10 weeks
- VA has a summer internship as well
- Budget: we have \$5,000 after everything is "spent"
 - We should budget \$800 for the interdisciplinary IV workshop for supplies
 - Ellis coordinates this, so she just asks for a little help for NSC budget

- We have been approached by a student asking for \$500 for a conference in the near future. We will either meet her in person or through e-mail: we will ask her a set of questions on how she will be using the money and make a final decision on how much we will be able to give her.
