Meeting Minutes:

Meeting called to order at 4:39 pm by Mathew Zaharenios, SOHP Council President and Anna Todd, SOHP Council Vice President seconded the motion to begin the meeting.

1. Mathew Zaharenios announces that October is an important celebratory month for the School of Health Professions. October is National PT Month, as well as Medical Ultrasound Awareness Month. We also celebrate National Midwifery Week and National PA Week, on October 6th-12th.

2. PA Club is currently holding a “PA Career Exploration and Practice” workshop, aiming to increase awareness of the PA profession, in honor of PA week. This workshop will educate grade school students about the PA profession, and will also incorporate aspects of clinical medicine/practice regarding cardiac health, to commemorate Sudden Cardiac Arrest Awareness Month (October).

Two potential dates are Wednesday 10/23 or Wednesday 10/30. DMI will finalize the details and communicate that information with SOHP Council ASAP.

5. Mathew Zaharenios asks attendees for their opinions on hosting another SOHP Breakfast event; all attendees are in favor.

6. Mathew Zaharenios asks voting members to vote on the following proposal: moving \$500 from the SOHP Council’s “Programs and Projects” account, to the “Meetings” account. All are in favor.

7. COTAD is planning a winter clothing drive event for the homeless in November. More details will follow.

8. Rachel Chang, Health Informatics (HI) representative, is requesting to create a HI club. She will send an email with her plan and budget request.
