      - Article III Section 2 Voting Representatives (clarification): "The number of voting representatives may be increased or decreased through the applicable amendment process, provided that the number of voting representatives shall always be an odd number to prevent ties on voting matters."

- Article VI. Finances Section D **Fundraising** (clarification): "The SPH Council may conduct fundraising activities only if and when any fundraising activities have been *reviewed with the SUNY Downstate Philanthropy department to avoid conflict with equivalent fundraising efforts, be pre-approved by the FSA, and deposited in accordance with Article VI.B.2"*
