- Budget for the 2023-2024 school year

-Currently unsure of the activities fee income as we are waiting to see how many students are enrolled for the school year. (Can increase or decrease based on enrollment rate). FSA did not provide information on the activities fee income for 2023/24. (\$14,414.94 will roll over to the upcoming school year as that is the remaining amount from the current 2022-2023 school year). -\$3,000 proposed for conference support, \$15,000 put towards events, \$1,000 put towards programs and projects.

-overall proposed budget for the 2023-2024 school year is \$21,054.94

Motion to pass the 2023-2024 SPH budget by Janille Williams. Motion is seconded by Brianna Caldwell-Williams, Moyouri Bhattacharjee, and Malika Abrams. We received a unanimous vote by the voting members of the school of Public Health to submit the proposed budget for the upcoming school year.

Updates from most recent meeting with Dean Demissie

-Faculty are now required to respond to student emails and address concerns within 48 hours. -Discussing group advising with students to assist with peer feedback and address multiple concerns at once time.

-Discussed hosting career development day and providing free, professional headshot photos for SPH students.

-Faculty/Staff awards proposal to recognize 2 faculty or staff members!! We want to be able to recognize faculty and staff who really help all students within the school of public health.

-Sip and Paint event was supposed to be May 30th but was not able to be had as there was no available space to hold the event in the student center. The new proposed date is June 9th to make sure that students and staff can attend prior to the start of the summer semester. The second date will be held in August to welcome newly enrolled students depending on how the event goes on June 9th.
