Approving budget for 2024-2025 school year

Currently unsure of the activities fee income as we are waiting to see how many students are enrolled for the school year. (Can increase or decrease based on enrollment rate). FSA did not provide information on the activities fee income for 2024/25. (\$17,511.83 or less will roll over to the upcoming school year as that is the remaining amount from the current 2023/24 school year as of March 2023. Additional expenses including payments to be made to Ernie, recent events expenses and conference support have not been adjusted for.)

- \$5,000 proposed for conference support,
- \$13,720.90 put towards events,
- \$1,000 put towards programs and projects,
- \$500 towards clubs
- \$400 towards meeting expenses.

Motion to pass the 2024-2025 SPH budget by Janille Williams. Motion is seconded by Breanna Watson. We received a unanimous vote by the voting members of the school of Public Health to submit the proposed budget for the upcoming school year.

Student Concerns

- Teaching Assistants and professors are not responsive to students' emails in a timely manner. As per our student handbook, faculty and staff are expected to reply back to students' emails within 48 hours. Based on discussions, we were able to resolve one of the problems at the meeting. The student emailed the TA via Brightspace but checked their regular email for the response. The TA responded via Brightspace directly to the students' concerns on two occasions. Everyone was encouraged to check their original message source for responses.
- Students have also been advised to email or call the IT help desk (718-270-HELP) with Brightspace related concerns and with having technical related problems and concerns.
- Students have also expressed their concerns regarding the Applied Practice Experience and making sure that they are properly prepared to complete their APEx and apply for careers post-graduation. Students are advised to reach out to the APEx coordinator Danvy Troung and join the weekly round-ups to be able to speak to Danvy directly, as well as, be updated on job postings and how to successfully complete the APEx.
- Students who called upon the Downstate leadership for transparency in reporting its financial disclosures, met with Dean Putman and President Riley. They have requested to meet SPH Dean Demissie and will do so in the summer semester.
