- a. Budget Requests
  - i. Association of Women Surgeons
    - 1. After brief discussion, the following motion was made by S. Jain and seconded by M. Garcia
    - 2. Motion: To deny their budget request of \$100. Motion denied unanimously until AWS becomes a recognized student organization.
      - a. \$100 will be approved from Programs and Projects Account 40-70173-016-30001 to AWS Account
  - ii. Global Health
    - 1. After brief discussion, the following motion was made by S. Jain and seconded by M. Garcia
    - 2. Motion: To not approve their new budget request. **Motion passed unanimously**. Students were encouraged to look for how these students were funded for the Emory competition in the past, UC does not fund individuals for this event.
  - iii. Student Simulation Committee
    - 1. After brief discussion, the following motion was made by S. Jain and seconded by O. Ogundipe
    - 2. Motion: To approve their new budget request of \$150. Motion passes unanimously.
    - \$150 was approved from Programs and Projects Account 40-70173-016-30001 to Student Simulation Account <u>40-703</u>76-016
- b. Center Wide Committee Update
  - i. Last meeting was Dec 11th
  - ii. Downstate will get subsidy for demolishing the parking garage around April. It will cost \$70-80 million to create a new parking garage and interim parking solutions are being discussed.
- c. SUNY SA updates
  - i. Welcome Carlos Cobo from SUNY SA Graduate Student Representative
  - ii. SUNY Stony Brook student. SUNY SA is a student advocacy organization. An advocacy agenda was created and discussed with elected officials. February 12th Higher Education Advocacy Day.

- Biggest initiatives from graduate schools typically focus on research-related concerns. An initiative/task force/subcommittee was created to address these issues.
- d. SUNY SA election for Spring 2019 Spring 2020
  - i. 2 applicants: Erika Boucard 6:30pm; Jack Jnani 6:50pm
  - ii. Erika Boucard was elected as the new SUNY SA rep for the Spring 2019 -Spring 2020 by a unanimous vote with 1 abstain
- e. University Council member vacancy
  - i. Nomainees: Timothy Morello, Yamina Kezadri
  - Timothy Morello was voted unanimously with one abstaining as the new university council member for the remainder of the Fall 2018 - Spring 2019 cycle. Yamina Kezadri forfeited her nomination.
- f. Constitution Revisions
  - i. Motion: To fill both SUNY SA positions in the Fall; motioned by M. Garcia and seconded by S. Jain.
    - 1. 7:5 vote in favor of filling both SUNY SA positions in the Fall
  - ii. Motion: To allow both SUNY council representatives to be voting members; motioned by M. Garcia and seconded by T. Morello.
    - 1. Unanimous vote in favor of both SUNY council representatives having their own vote for a total of 14 UC voting members
- g. Government Shutdown
  - i. Governor A. Cuomo orders:
    - waive late fees and postpone payments for those affected (federal employees, dependents of federal employees, or students whose federal loans are delayed)
    - 2. Researchers waiting for grants that are federally funded should expect delays as federal reviewers are off the job
  - ii. Campus email from Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs, J. Putman:
    - Federal financial aid program not one of the ones shut down. If you were eligible and applied for funding through summer 2019 you will get your disbursements. If you are impacted in any other way please go to the Financial aid office (BSB1-112) for guidance.
    - Contact Bursar Office directly if you are a "federal employee, dependents of federal employees, and/or student who is dependent on loans from the federal government that may be delayed"... "must request the extension before your initial payment deadline."
    - 3. International students contact Office of Student Affairs if you are "planning to travel outside the United States in the near future, or you are planning to apply for an extension of your visa, for practical training, or for other programs administered by the Department of State or the Department of Homeland Security."
