

# ACCESS OF INFORMATION FORM

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In compliance with the Federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, information from your student records are prohibited from being provided to a third party such as information on grades, billing, tuition and fees assessment, financial aid (including scholarships, grants, work-study, or loan amounts) and other student record information.
