1-4 - KCHC - Kings County Hospital Center (NYC HHC). F3 fellows will rotate at this site through the Medical Intensive Care unit (MICU) ,Surgical Intensive Care unit/Tauma Intensive care unit.SICU/Trauma and Neuro ICU's.

5-6- UHB- University Hospital of Brooklyn (SUNY), F3 fellows will rotate through the MICU and Cardio-Thoracic Intensive care unit – CT-ICU.

7-KCHC or UHB – CCU – F3 fellows have the option of rotating through the cardiology Critical Care units both the sites offer training with ACS patients, hemodynamic monitoring, emergency cardioversion, transcutaneous pacemakers, IABP (Intra Aortic balloon pumps).

8-CIH - Coney Island Hospital (NYC HHC) . F3 fellows rotate through their busy MICU. This site is one of the best sites for airway management skills , sine the fellows do the emergency airways with the respiratory therapists.

9- VA - Brooklyn Veterans Administration Medical Center – This MICU rotation at this site serves a different subset of population and hence enhances the richness of the MICU rotation.

10- LMC- NYU –Lutheran Medical center. At this rotation the fellows also get to experience the Step-Down aspect of the MICU care.

11-The Fellows will be given the time to either work on their existing project or participate and present QA/QI projects. The electives options offered are : antibiotic stewardship at UHB, palliative care Medicine at UHB or VA or KCHC, Anesthesia for airway management at KCHC or UHB. Electives can be arranged at institutions outside the program, such arrangements have to be made in advance and need the approval of the program director and the administrator.
