This newsletter became a platform to communicate with graduates of the Downstate Orthopaedic Surgery residency program, a group that exceeds 200 fine surgeons. Our objective is for you to stay involved with the academic activities of the program as we grow and continue our efforts to achieve excellence in orthopaedic care. Our graduates of 2019 have all matched into their top choices for fellowships, and I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate them. The department continues to grow as we have recently added new faculty to the Hand/Upper Extremity, Sports Medicine, Adult

## Message from the Program Director: Carl B. Paulino, MD




I would like to welcome everyone to the Annual Alumni AAOS Reception at the The Venetian, Room 1002 on March 15, 2019 at 6:45 PM. This year, the program had a strong presence at AAOS with a growing body of research both in quality and quantity. The department continues to work closely with Downstate College of Medicine to educate and support medical students who are interested in orthopaedic surgery, and there have been more than 75 medical students over the past 2 years. This year alone, the Downstate Orthopaedic Research Laboratory accommodated **70+ Downstate Medical students**, 20+ additional MD and undergrad students, and 5 high school

students. We have continued our collaboration with institutions including *NYU* Langone Orthopedic Hospital/HJD, Hospital for Special Surgery, and Cleveland Clinic, as well as the International Spine Study Group (ISSG) to continue our research productivity. Our goal is to continue this trend and build on our foundation to advance research coming out of Downstate. In the last year, we received 2 AFSH grants, started building a gait and motion analysis registry with the use of our human performance laboratory, and designed and validated the **Dubousset Functional Test**, a novel functional assessment with tremendous potential; read about it soon in *CORR*. Finally, it is my pleasure to share with you that between the two Academies (AAOS 2018 and AAOS 2019), our research has been presented at more than 25 **national and international meetings**, with the **total podium and poster presentations exceeding** <u>145</u>! 

Dr. Charles Ekstein is the latest orthopaedic surgeon to join our team. Dr. Ekstein is a fellowship-trained specialist in hand, upper extremity and microsurgery and joined in September 2018. He treats all types of upper extremity musculoskeletal diseases and injuries from the fingertips to the shoulder. A major focus of his practice is upper extremity trauma.

Dr. Ekstein completed his medical degree at Boston University and his orthopaedic surgery residency at Northwell Health – Long Island Jewish Medical Center. Following residency, he completed a fellowship in hand and upper extremity surgery at New York's Hospital for Special Surgery. He specializes in

the evaluation and treatment of all conditions related to the fingers, hand, wrist, forearm, elbow, and shoulder. This includes sports- and work-related injuries, degenerative and rheumatoid arthritis conditions, nerve compression syndromes, and traumatic reconstruction. He cares for upper extremity issues in patients of all ages, and has multiple publications to his name. He was also the recipient of the Stanley E. Asnis MD Clinical Excellence Award.

# Colin Y.L. Woon, MD



Dr. Colin Y.L. Woon joined our department in September 2018 as an Adult Reconstruction and Joint Replacement surgeon. Dr. Woon specializes in all aspects of adult reconstruction, including primary total hip and knee arthroplasty, revision and complex joint reconstructive procedures, fracture management, and periprosthetic joint complications. Dr. Woon arrives with a strong background in research, with his current efforts focused on novel solutions to common arthroplasty-related problems, arthroplasty complications, and orthopaedic implant and device development. He has over 45 peer-reviewed publications, countless orthopaedic meeting presentations, several musculoskeletal-related patents, and is a peer-reviewer for Journal of Arthroplasty and 8 more journals. He has multiple ongoing clinical and basic science

research studies. Dr. Woon received his medical degree from the National University of Singapore, followed by his residency in orthopaedic surgery at the University of Illinois at Chicago. Following residency, he completed his fellowship in Adult Reconstruction and Joint Replacement at New York's prestigious Hospital for Special Surgery.

## Downstate Faculty in the News - Steven Koehler, MD

Dr. Koehler is now performing **Wide Awake Local Anesthetic No Tourniquet (WALANT)** procedures in the E-building. He is the only reconstructive microsurgeon in Brooklyn and one of the few brachial plexus surgeons in the Tri-State Area. He performs Targeted Muscle Reinnervation for amputees and is one of the few surgeons on the East Coast performing toe-to-hand transplantation.

# Clinical Orthopaedics and Related Research<sup>®</sup>

Balance is an active process that requires harmony between posture and motion, and this is imperfectly represented by static radiographs alone. Our current understanding of how surgical deformity correction impacts functional mobility and daily activities of our patients is incomplete; it is only assessed through quality-of-life measures without a more objective and guantified tool. Building on our work in gait analysis, SUNY **Downstate** is the **first center** to establish normative reference data in asymptomatic subjects for a novel, multi-domain physical function and balance assessment, the **Dubousset** Functional Test (DFT). Demonstrating its feasibility and safety, this work was recently accepted to Clinical Orthopaedics and Related Research (CORR), and multi-center validation in a population of spine pathology patients is under way at SUNY Downstate, Hospital for Special Surgery, and Clinique Francheville in Périgueux.

## Two Years, Two American Foundation for Surgery of the Hand (AFSH) Fast Track Grants

A Pilot Study: Does Nerve Wrapping Prevent Neural Adhesions and Permit Nerve Gliding?

We sought to determine the efficacy of various anti-adhesive techniques via a peak force model to quantify nerve gliding and adhesion to surrounding tissue. The proposed project tests our hypothesis that nerve wraps decrease the adhesiveness of nerves to surrounding tissue through decreased contact and reduced fibroblast collagen formation after transection and repair.



## Daniel M. Zuchelli, MD (PGY1)

2018 Grant Recipient Does Compressive Neuropathy Lead to an Increase in Fracture Risk? This study proposes to assess the effects of compressive neuropathy on bone. Using a rabbit sciatic nerve model, our research team will aim to examine the downstream macroscopic and microscopic changes in the bony architecture.



## Downstate Orthopaedics is the Primary Trial Site for a Novel Implant

Featured Research

*Dr. Steven M. Koehler* is leading two studies that evaluate a new implant for distal humerus fracture fixation. **SUNY Downstate** was selected as the <u>sole testing facility</u> for the biomechanical validation/testing and will also serve as the lead site in a multi-center clinical trial in concert with **Duke University**, **Massachusetts General Hospital**, and the **Hellenic Airforce General Hospital** in **Athens**, **Greece**.

## **Field-Test Version**

In the field of hand surgery, the aim of many surgical interventions is to improve the patient's quality of life, therefore to establish the effectiveness of the interventions, the impact on the patient's quality of life must be measured. A soon-to-be published systematic review recently revealed that there is currently no patient-reported outcome (PRO) instrument available that can be used for the majority of patients with a hand condition. This satisfies the best practices for development, as defined by the Medical Outcomes Trust and the US FDA.

Following Phase 1 development by Donald Lalonde and the University of Adelaide, **SUNY Downstate** is one of only a few sites in the United States, and among select institutions worldwide, to be enrolling patients into a Phase 2 Field Test of the HAND-Q, led by *Dr. Steven M. Koehler*.


