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Prostate Adenocarcinoma Metastasis to the Mediastinum: A Case Report and Literature Review

Metastatic prostate cancer to mediastinal lymph nodes is rare. This case report describes a 68-year-old man with an incidental finding of a 9.0 cm x 7.4 cm left mediastinal mass encasing the great vessels and pericardium. A biopsy via video-assisted thoracic surgery was performed and pathological examination revealed metastatic prostate adenocarcinoma. Significantly elevated levels of Prostate Specific Antigen further supported this diagnosis. Herein we review and discuss the literature and prevalence of prostate adenocarcinoma metastasis to mediastinal lymph nodes, a rare occurrence.

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
