

Your Profile: Claim or Create

Claim your profile

- Login using Institutional SSO.
- Click on your **name** in upper right corner and select **Claim Profile** in the user menu. Pivot-RP displays a list of potentially matching profiles based on your account information. If you see the correct profile, select **This is me** in the profile row.
- **Pivot-RP sends a confirmation with a verification URL to your email. Open the verification URL to claim the profile.**
- Otherwise, you will be asked to confirm if you have access to the email address listed on your Pivot profile. If you confirm you will receive a verification email.
- Please Note: You must use a 'downstate.edu' email address for access.

Create a profile

- If you do not find a profile for yourself, click the **Create a Profile** on the Claim Profile results page. Clicking the continue button will take you out of Pivot and to the profile creation tool.
- The first step will show your name as listed on your Pivot account and you will be prompted to add any additional names that you have used on publications.
- Pivot will confirm the email address on file for this account. Please Note: only users with a '@downstate.edu' email will have access to Pivot. You can add more details to your affiliation here.
- Click the Finish button when done.
- Your profile has been created and claimed. You can add more information to your profile by clicking on the **Edit Profile** button.

 - Added by, and are local to, your institution (internal)

Profile Features

- Open the user's personal website.
- Open the user's c.v. website.
- Open the user's publication page website.
- Send an email to the user.
- View funding opportunities that match the user's keywords or the user's department.
- Select the Publications tab to view the user's publications. When available, select the magnifying glass beside the publication title to see contents from the publication.


Create Research Groups

User Groups

User groups can be used in Pivot-RP to share information between users with similar areas of interest, such as funding opportunities, newsletters, and other communications. There are two types of user groups:

Personal Groups – user groups that any user can create and add users to. Only the creator can add users and information to personal groups.

Public Groups – user groups created by a Pivot-RP administrator that are visible to all users who can choose to join the group.
