

Institutional Scholarship Application for Medical Students 2021-2022

Medical Student Deadline: April 15, 2021

SUNY Downstate Medical Center has scholarship opportunities for students enrolled in the college of medicine who are economically disadvantaged. Awarding is based on the economic guideline listed below and award funding availability.

All students <u>must</u> provide <u>both</u> parental income on the FAFSA application and submit <u>signed</u> copies of their and their parents 2019 tax returns and/or non-taxable income. If a student's parents are separated or divorced, we need both parents' income to complete the application. Students who are married and/or have dependents must submit their spouse's <u>signed</u> 2019 tax return.

Students must be matriculated full time students (9 credits or more) to be considered for this award. Students must be in good academic standing to be eligible for this award.

Not every potential eligible student will get an award. SUNY Downstate will only notify students that are eligible for these awards. These awards are only for matriculated medical students. We anticipate having more eligible applicants than we are able to offer awards. Not all students will receive an award. Notifications and decisions will not begin until after the deadline dates. The scholarship committee will meet and make determinations on the number of awards and amount at that time. Awards are to be used for educational purposes only. Student's with duplicative outside awards will not be considered for SUNY Downstate institutional aid. Incomplete applications will not be considered for an award. Scholarship funds are disbursed through the Bursar's Office and if a student's billing is paid in full the Bursar will issue a refund. The SUNY Downstate Scholarship committee shall be the sole decision-maker regarding the award of any scholarship, and its decision shall be final.
