State University of New York offers a scholarship program to recruit, enroll, and retain students who will contribute to the diversity of the student body in the university's graduate and professional programs.

Eligibility: (Check all that applies)

- U.S. citizens or hold permanent resident status.
- Accepted as matriculated, full-time students (registering for at least 9 graduate credits each semester) in a graduate program. OR
- Currently enrolled doctoral candidates who have completed all degree requirements but the dissertation ("ABD").
- Students must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA each semester and making progress through their program to continue to receive funding.

How to Apply

Diversity Essay: Please state how you can contribute to the diversity of the student body in your program or school,

primarily by demonstrating that you have overcome a disadvantage in order to achieve success in higher education. (1-2 typed pages).
