Realize your dream of attending medical school with the Health Professions Scholarship Program (HPSP). Participants receive **full tuition, reimbursement for books and academic fees, and a monthly stipend of \$ 2,088**. If you are enrolled in or have received a letter of acceptance from an accredited medical school in the United States or Puerto Rico, you could be eligible. You could also receive a \$20,000 bonus.

As an HPSP recipient, you may apply for specialties that interest you most. You can apply for any of the Army’s Graduate Medical Education (GME) programs – six transitional programs and 68 residencies. If accepted, you’ll learn from leading medical experts in our state-of-the-art teaching hospitals. You can further develop specialized skills by taking part in one of 57 fellowships, held in conjunction with some of our country’s top teaching hospitals.
