



# Total Enrollment by Full- and Part-time Status Fall 2002 to Fall 2006





# Total Enrollment by Gender Fall 2002 to Fall 2006





## Total Enrollment by Ethnic Group Fall 2002 to Fall 2006





#### Total Enrollment by Student Level Fall 2002 to Fall 2006


