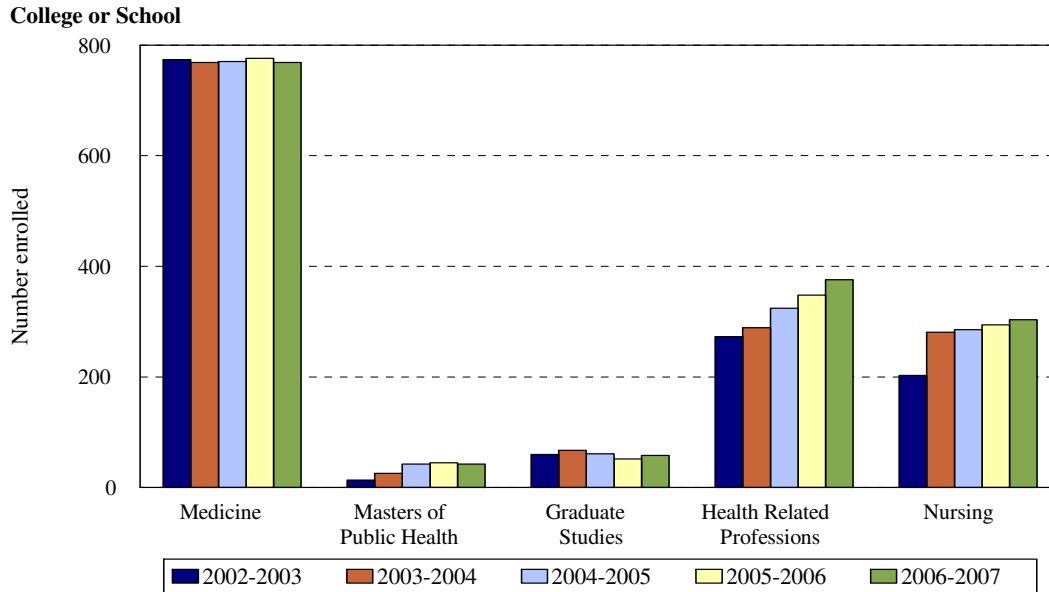

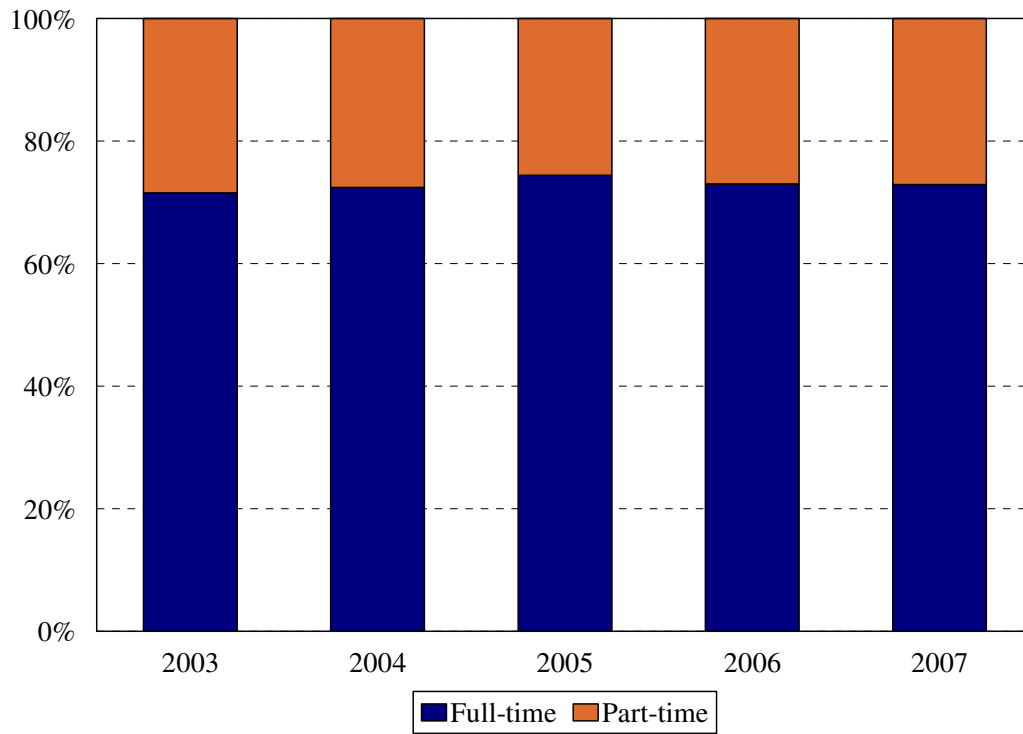

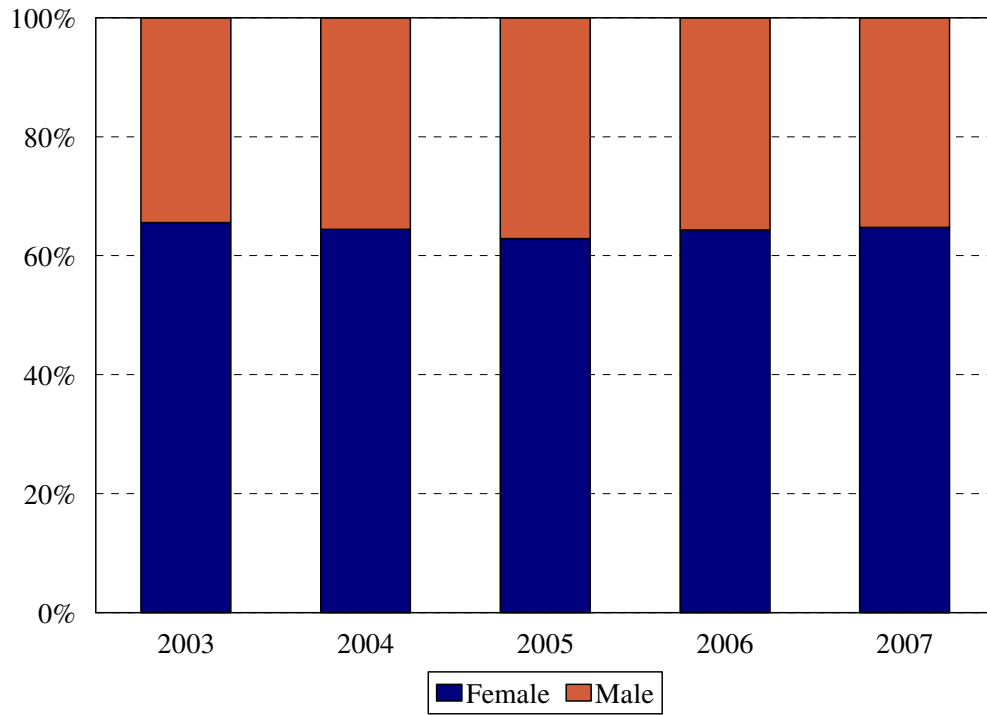
## Total Enrollment by Full- and Part-time Status Fall 2003 to Fall 2007

## Total Enrollment by Gender

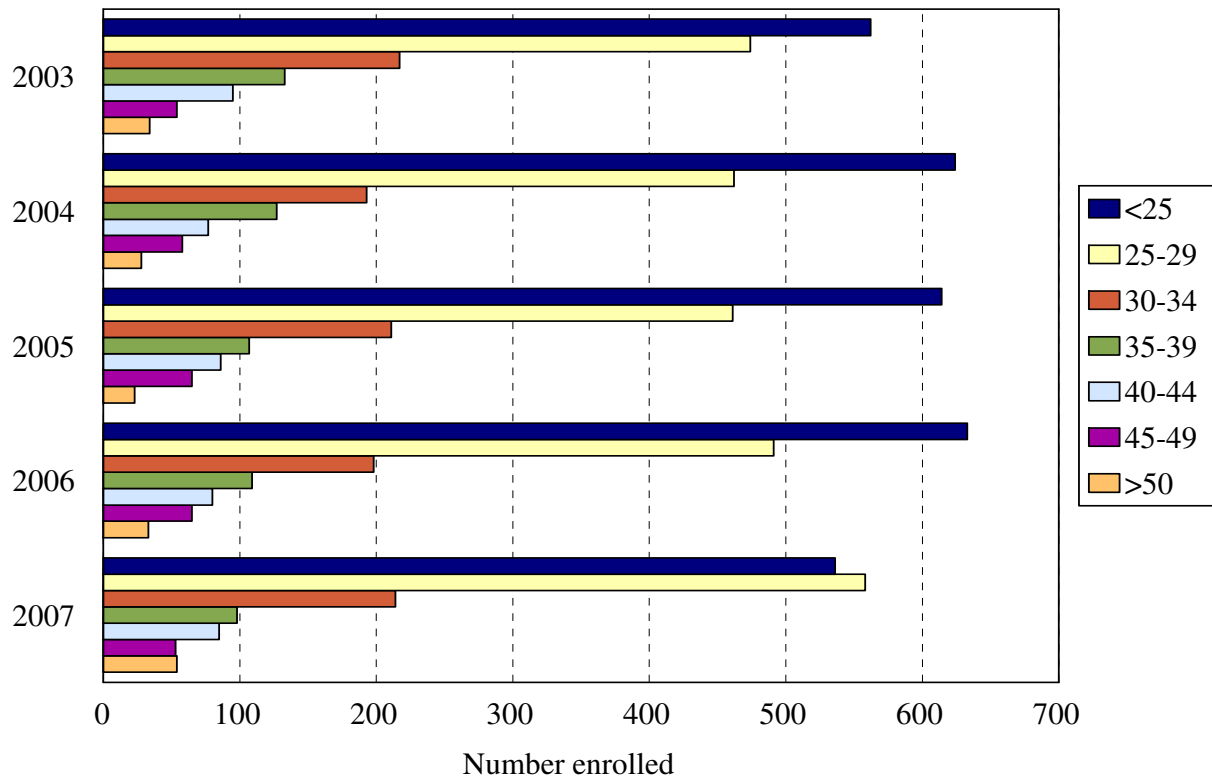

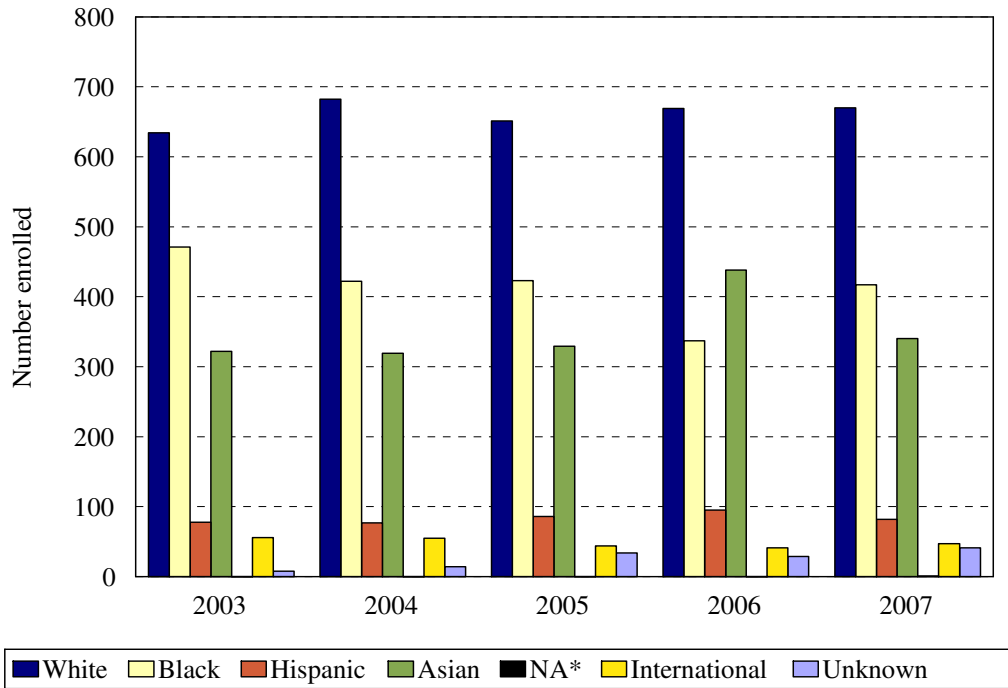

## Total Enrollment by Ethnic Group Fall 2003 to Fall 2007

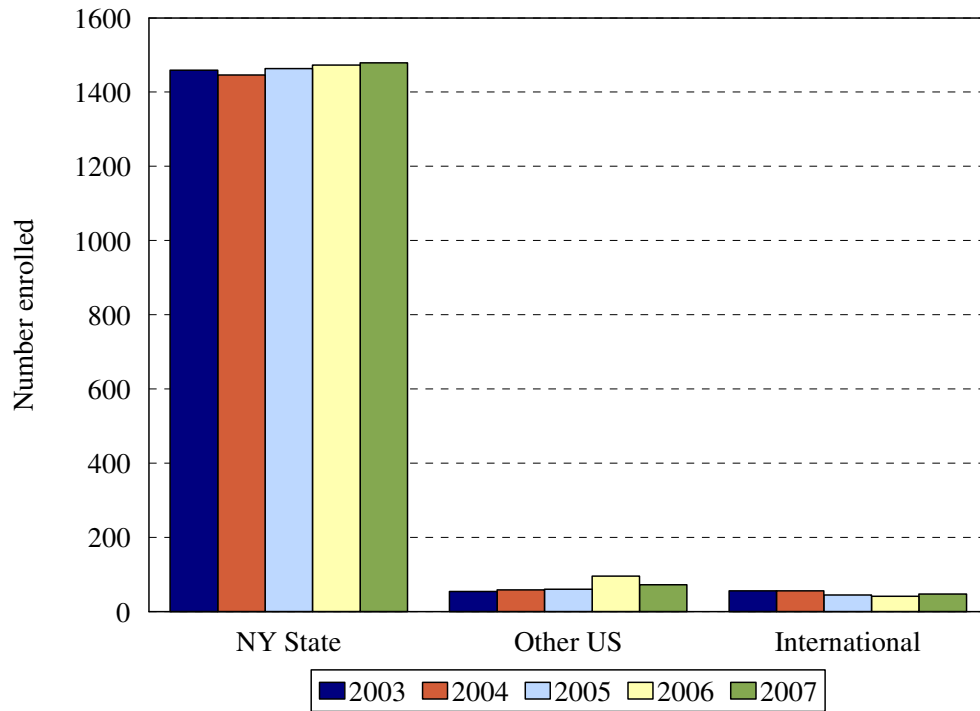

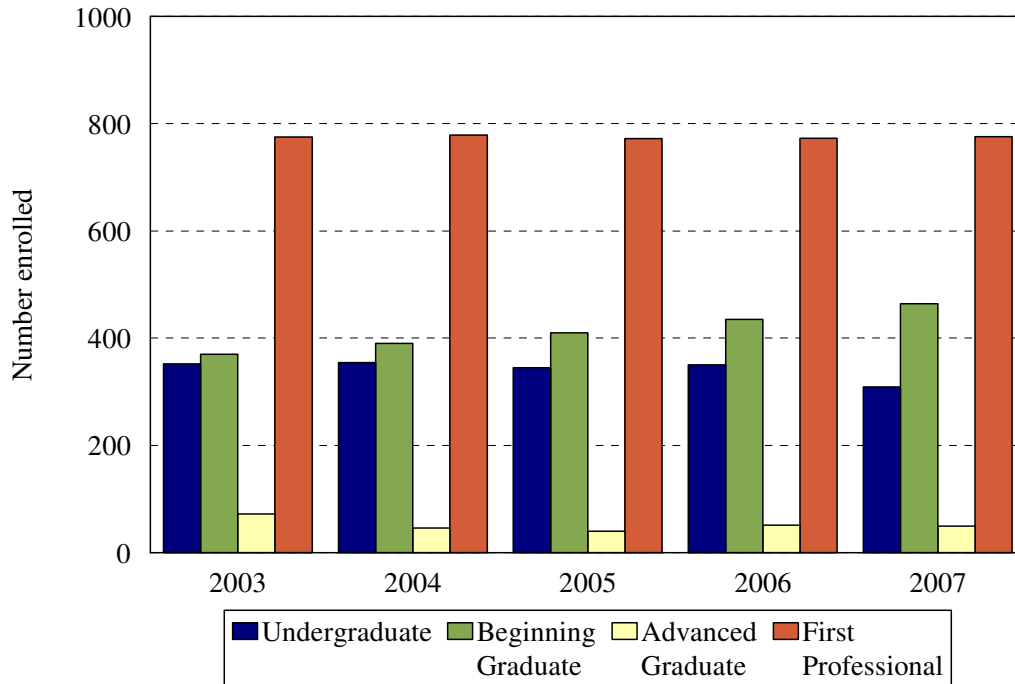

## Total Enrollment by Student Level Fall 2003 to Fall 2007



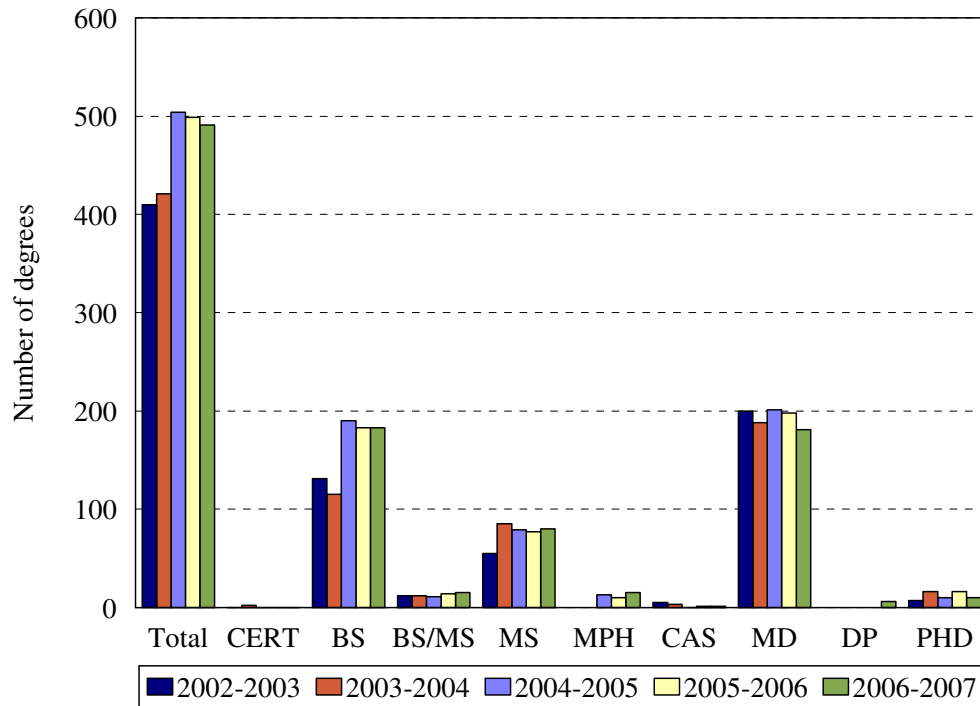
