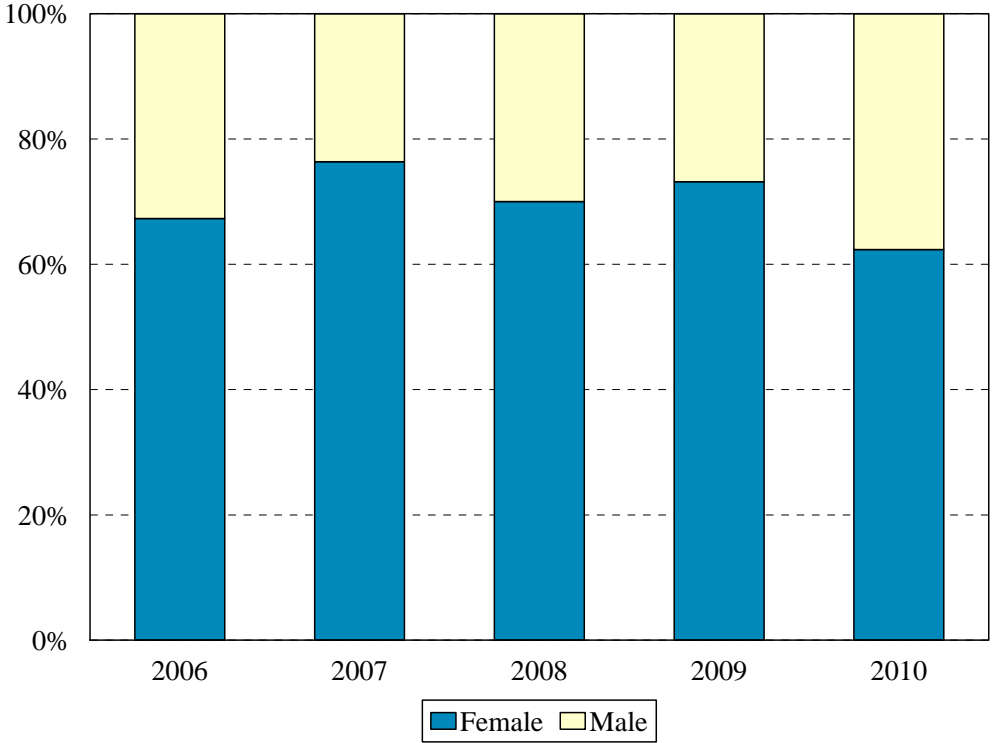

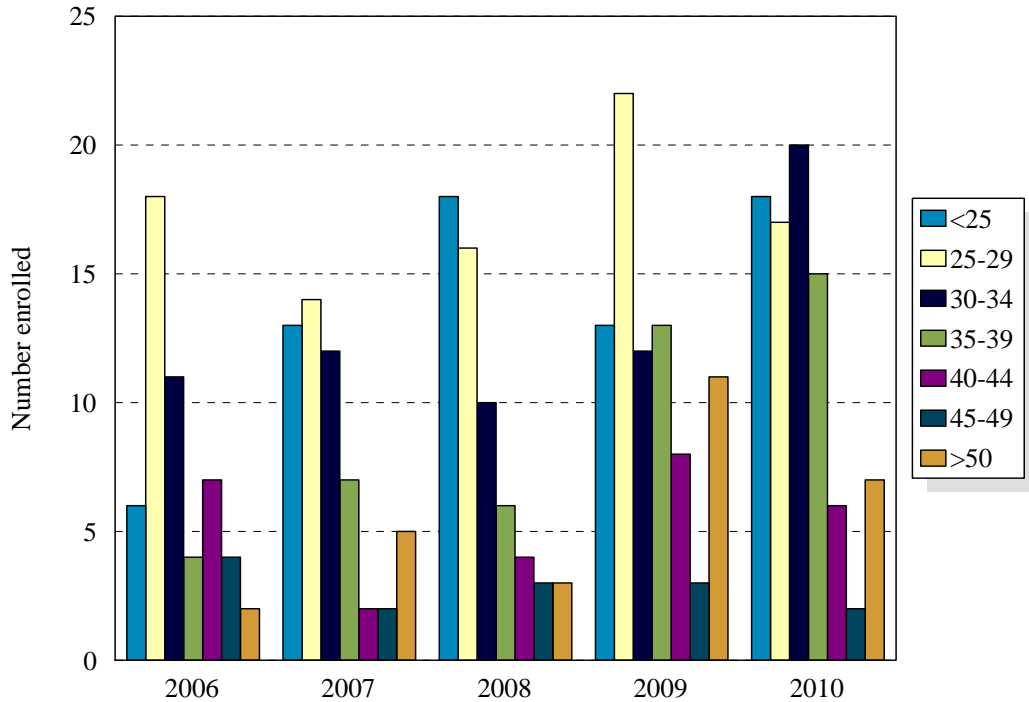

Fall 2006 to Fall 2010



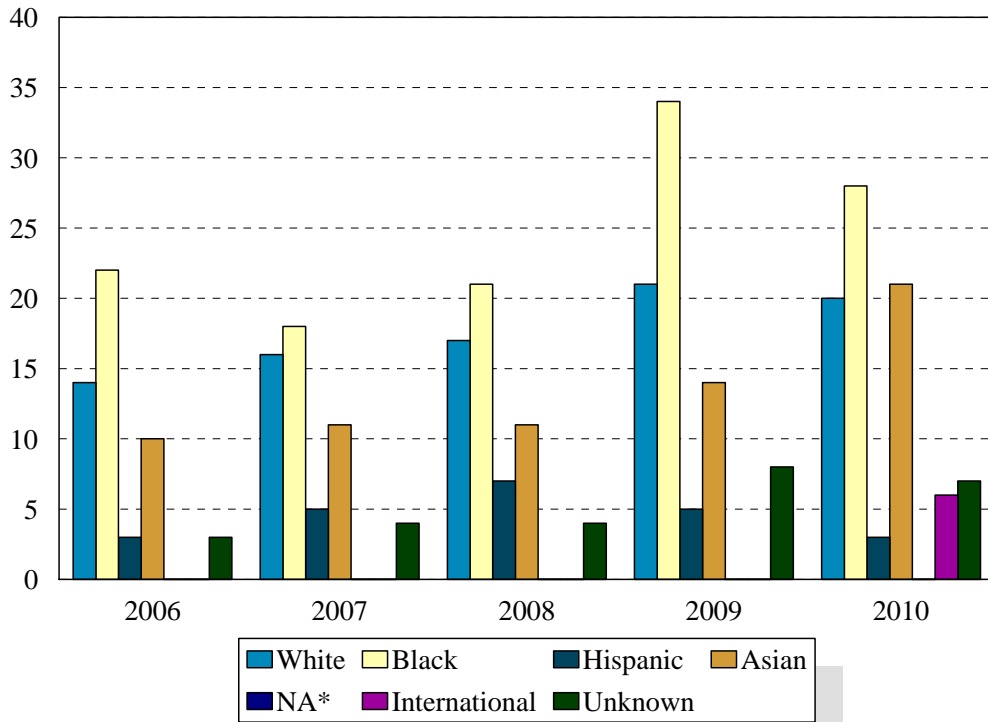

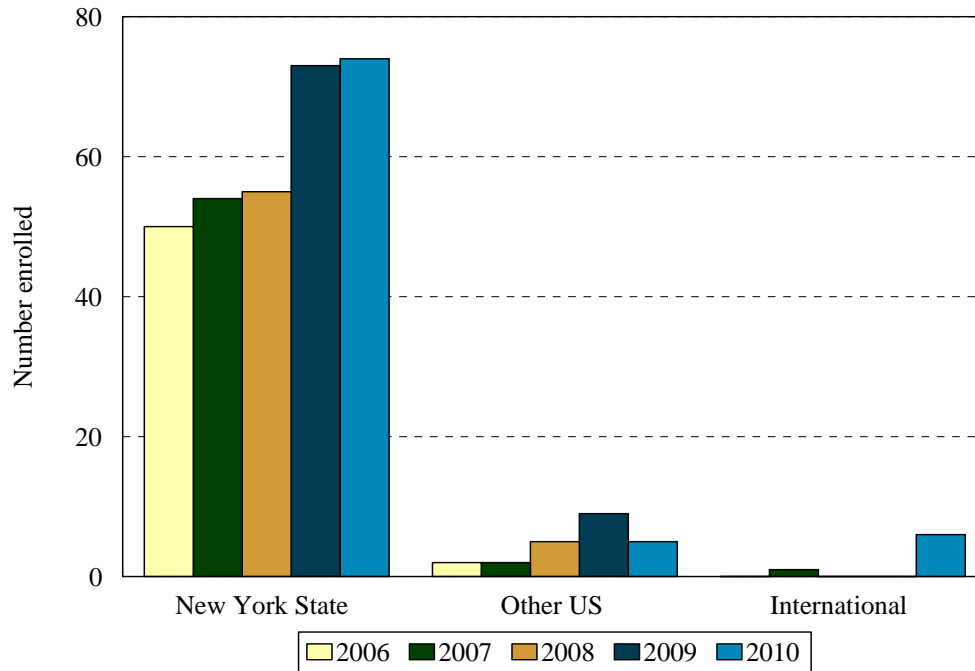

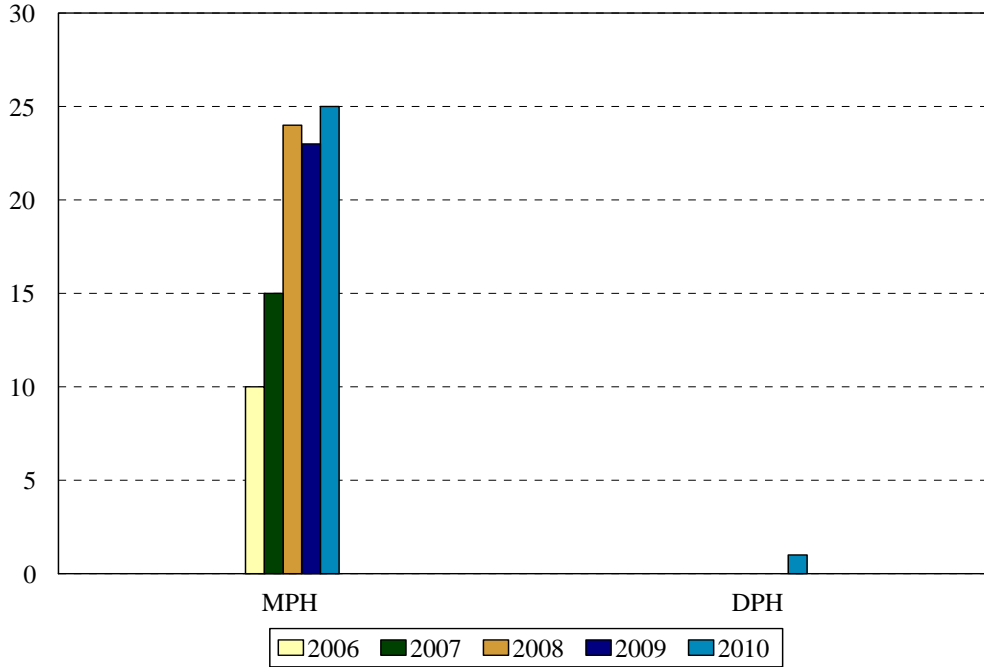
