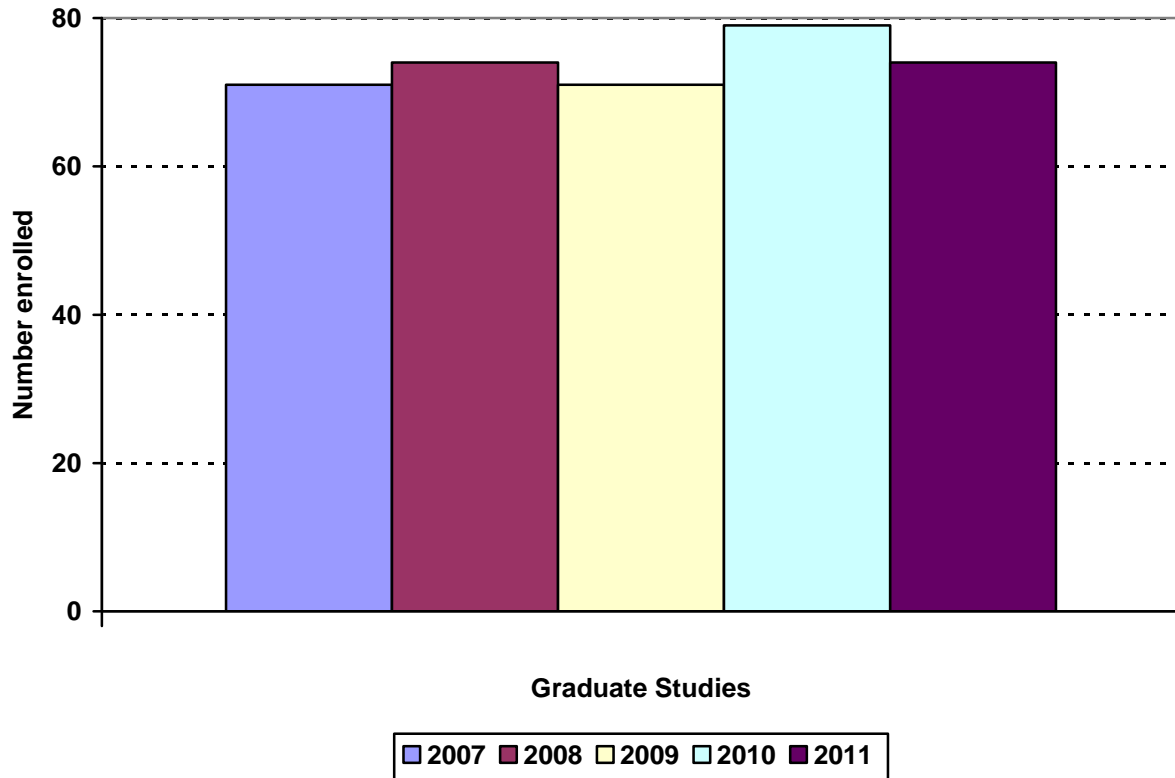


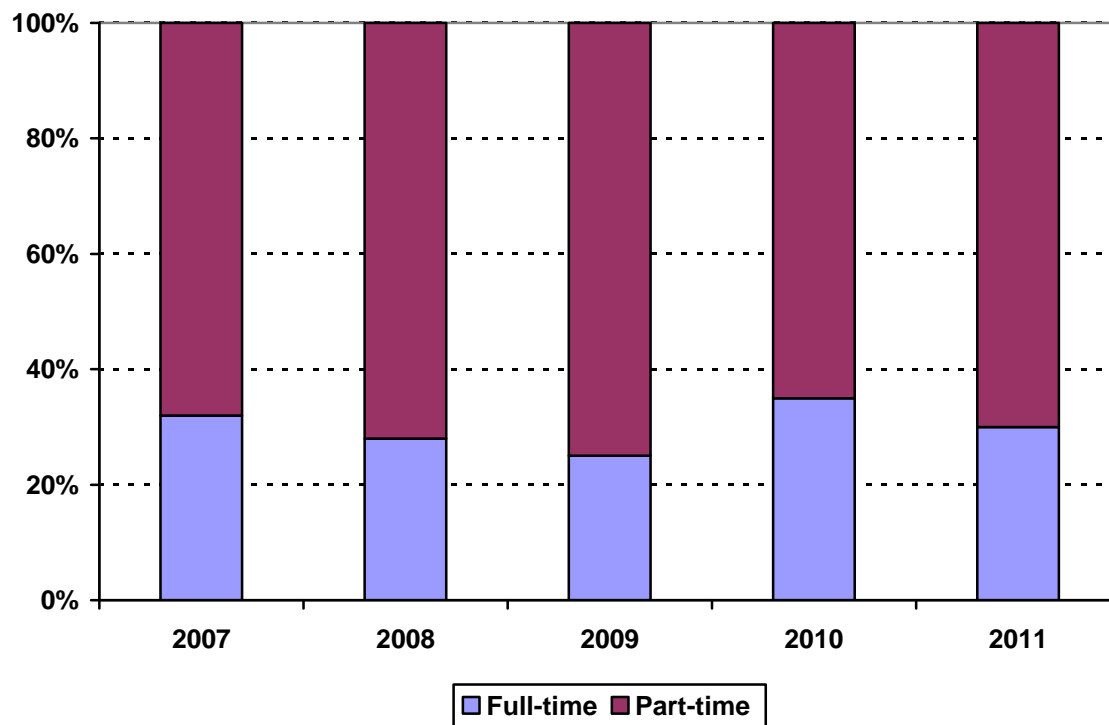

Fall 2007 to Fall 2011

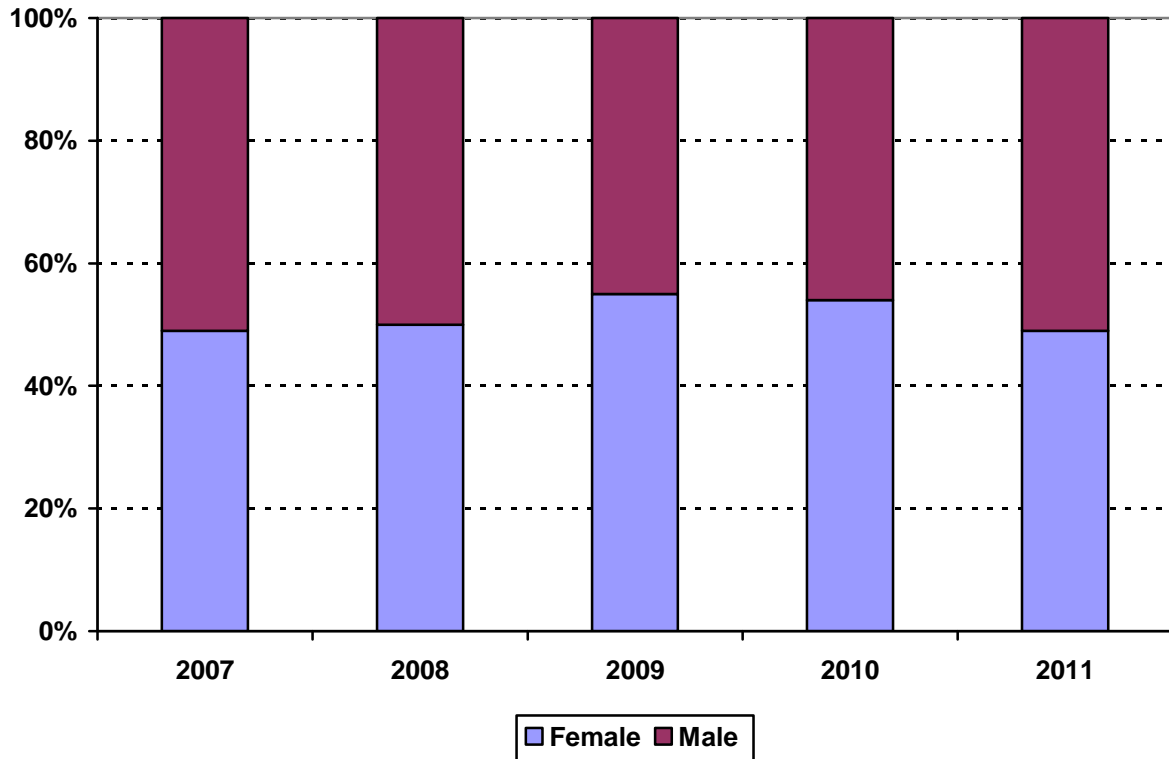

School of Graduates Studies Enrollment by Gender

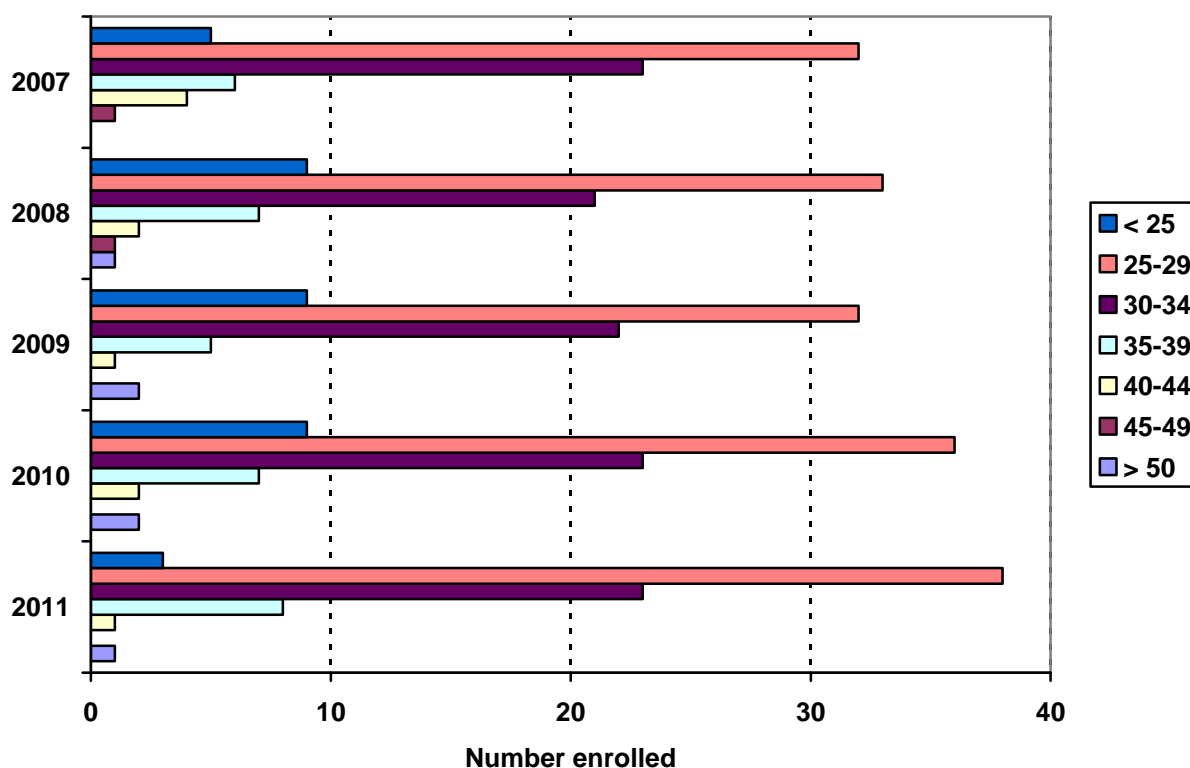

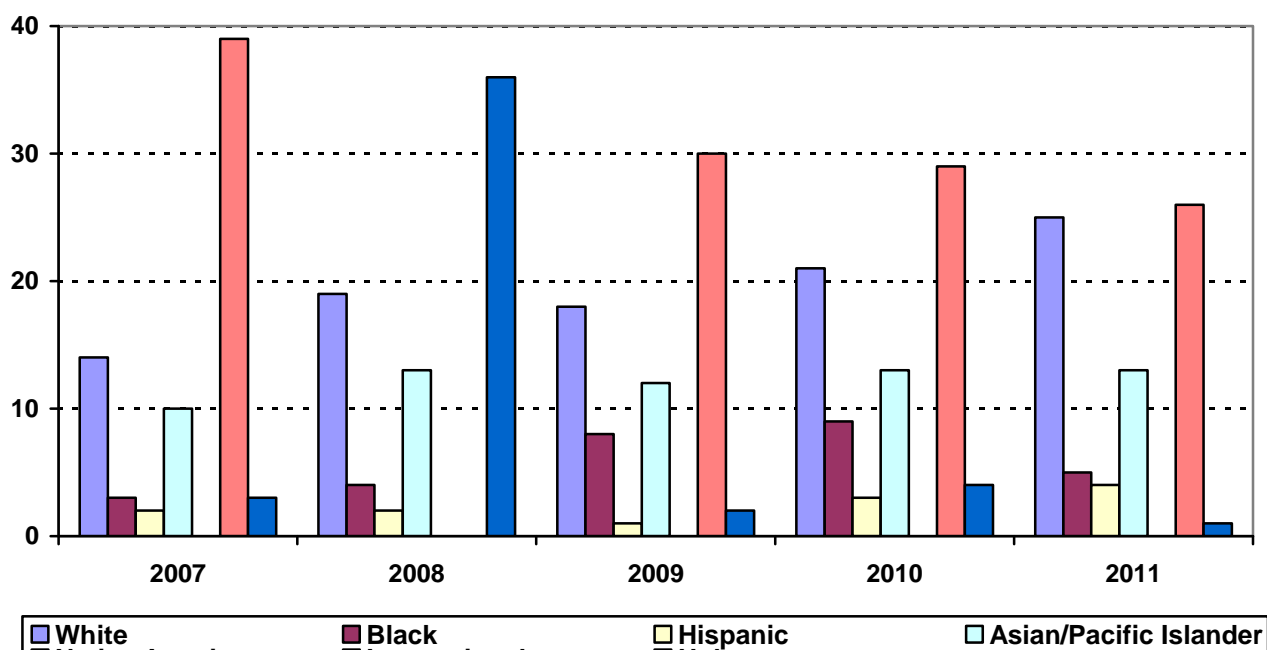

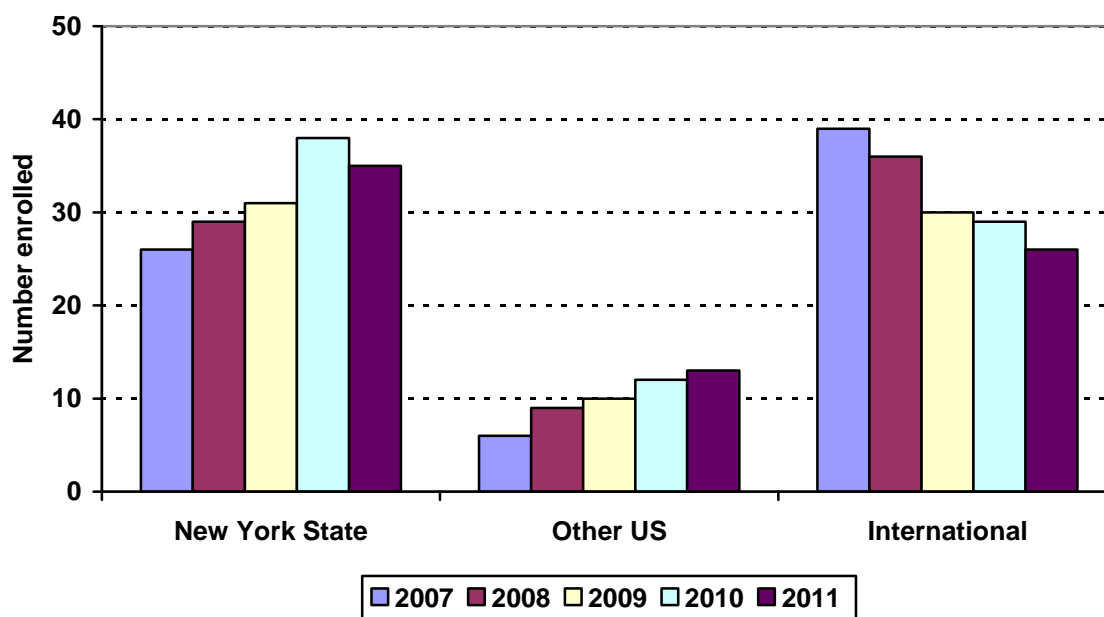

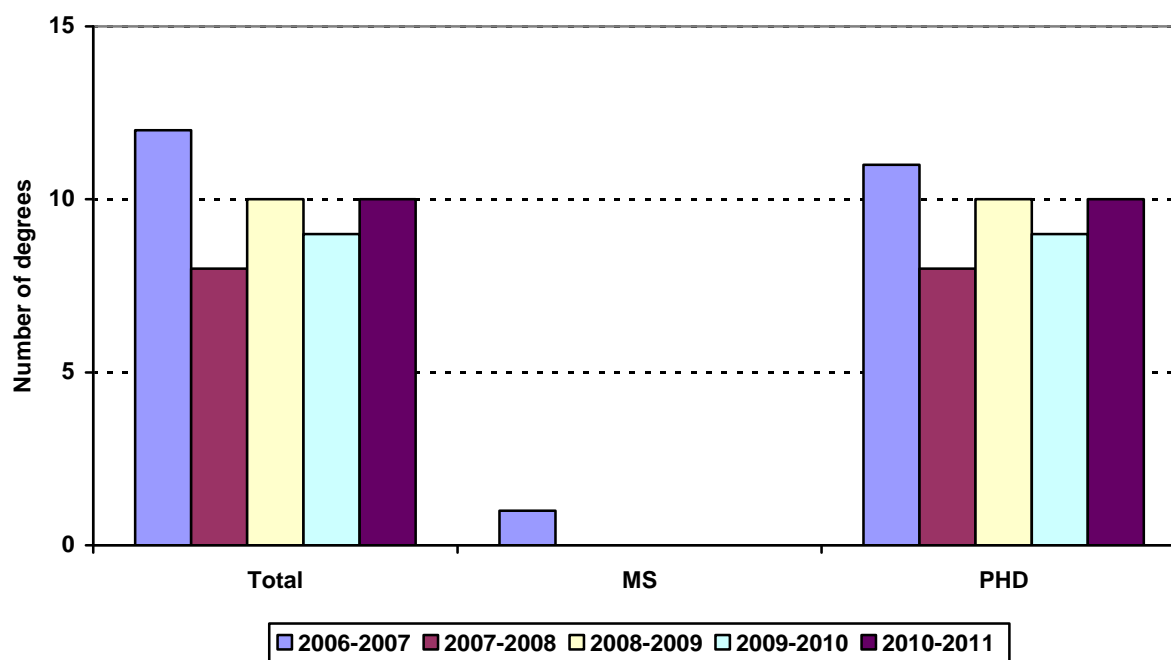
