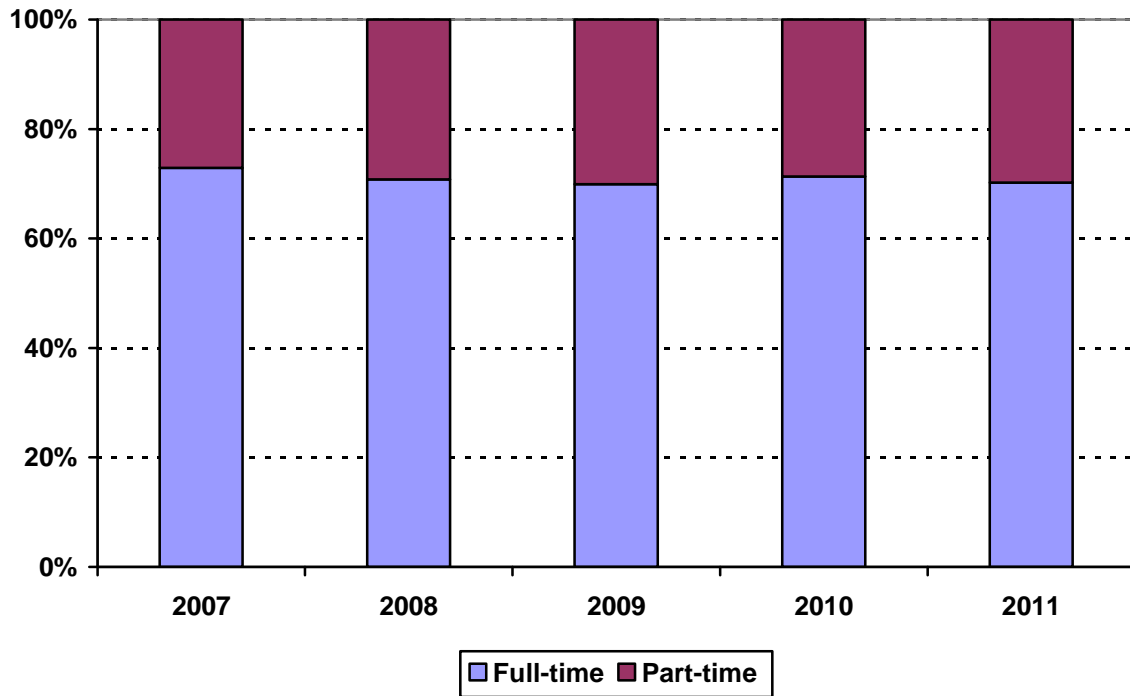

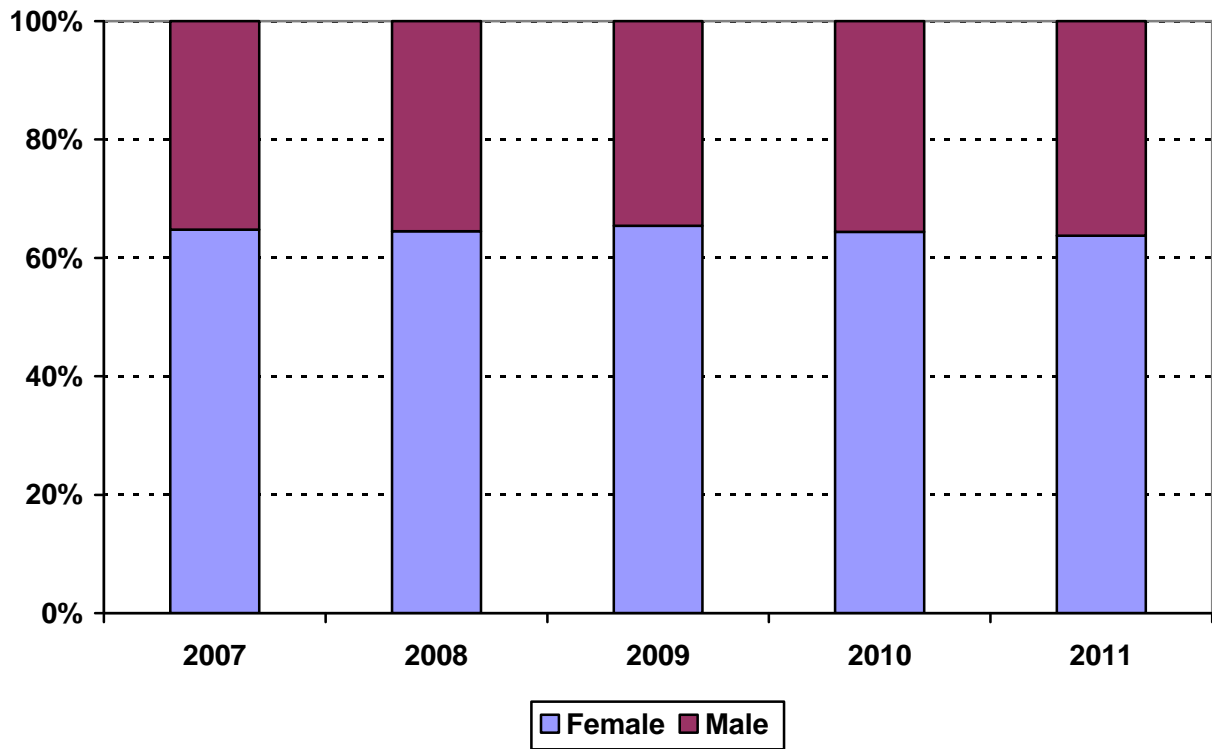
Full Time Equivalents (FTE) are computed as the sum over an academic year (summer, fall, and spring) of the following: 1) All undergraduate credits divided by 30, 2) all graduate credits with the exception of advanced Ph.D. and post-master's certificate students divided by 24, 3) medical student headcount for fall and spring divided by 2, and 4) full-time advanced Ph.D. and post master's certificate headcount plus .75 of the part-time advanced Ph.D. and post master's certificate headcount.

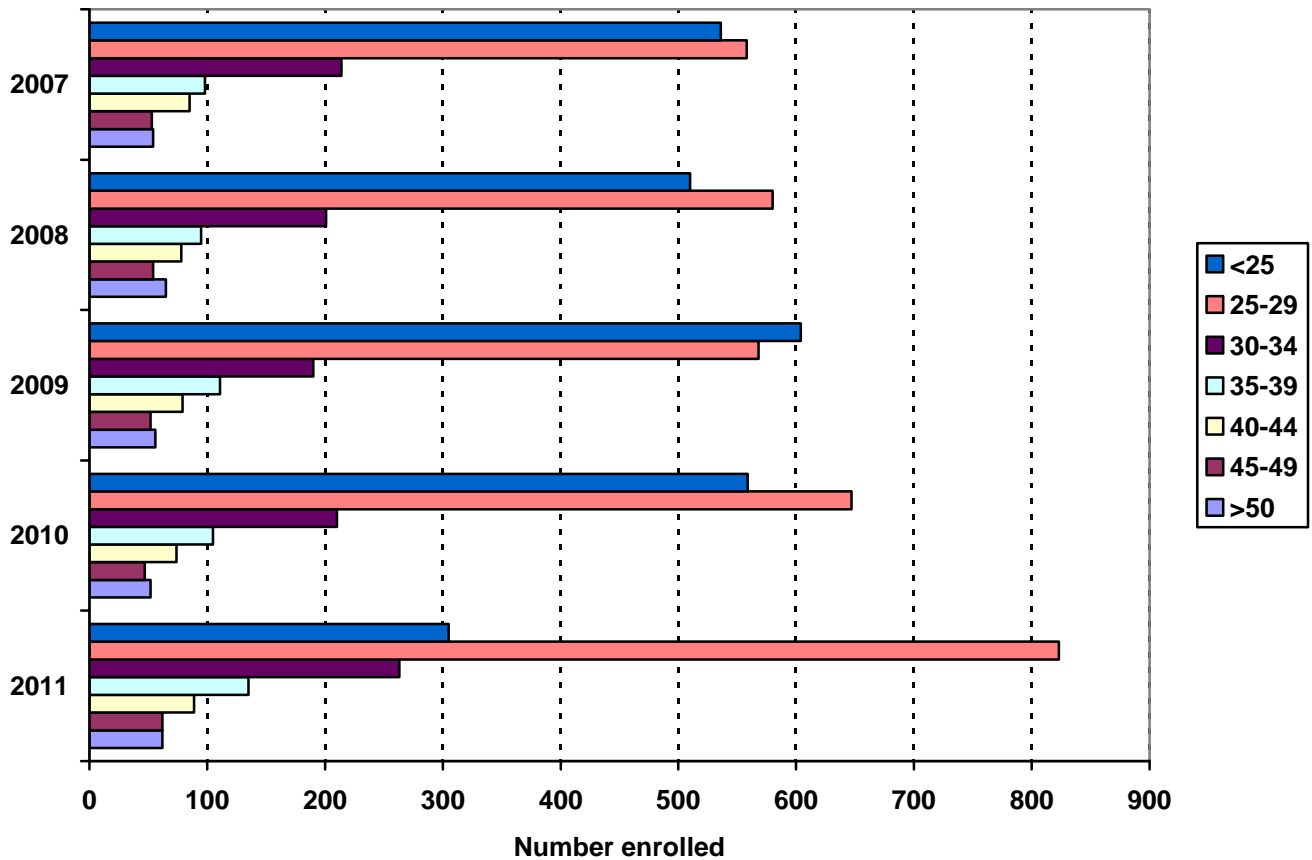
## Total Enrollment by Gender Fall 2007 to Fall 2011

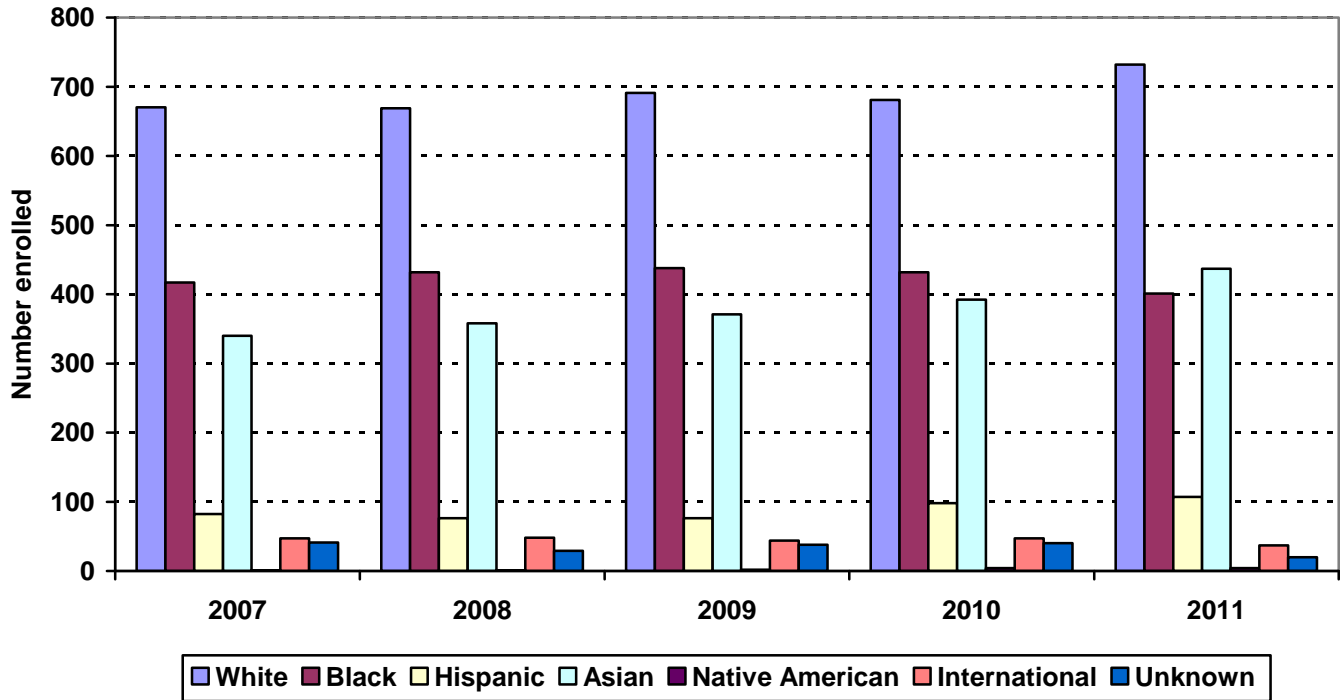

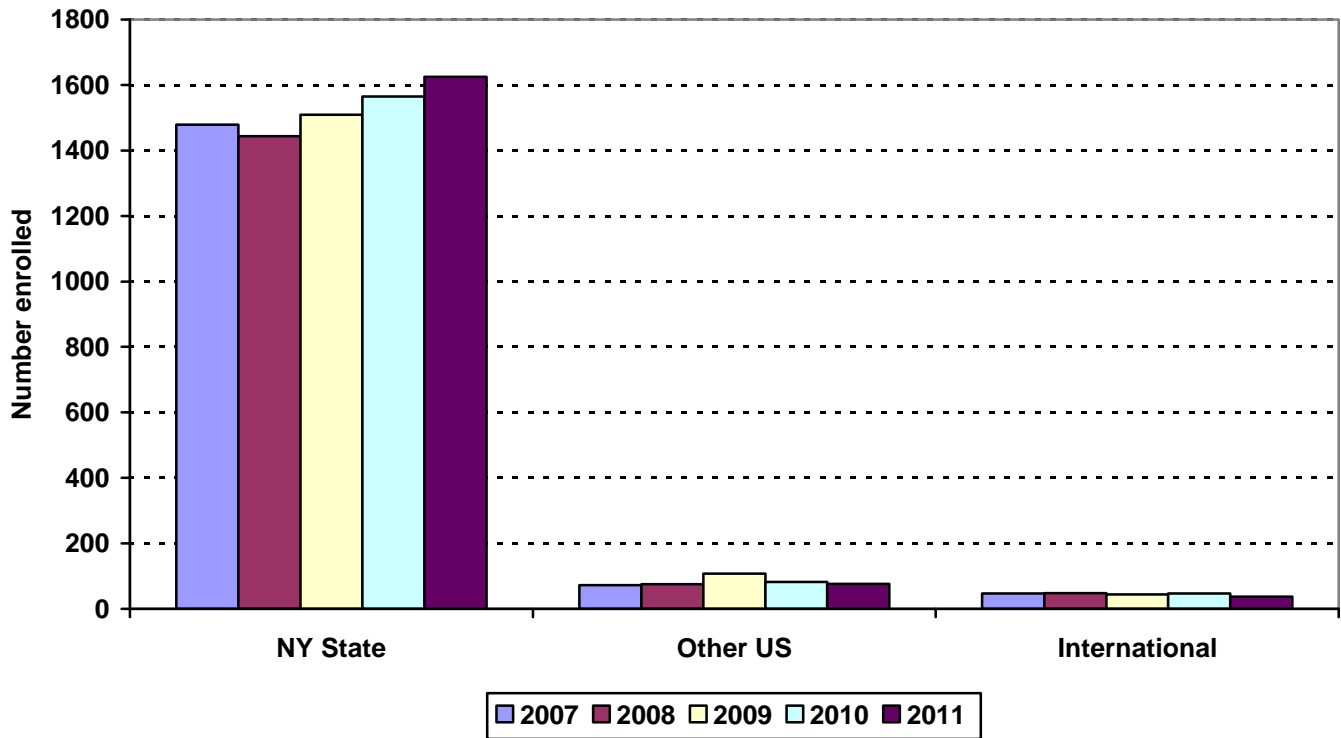

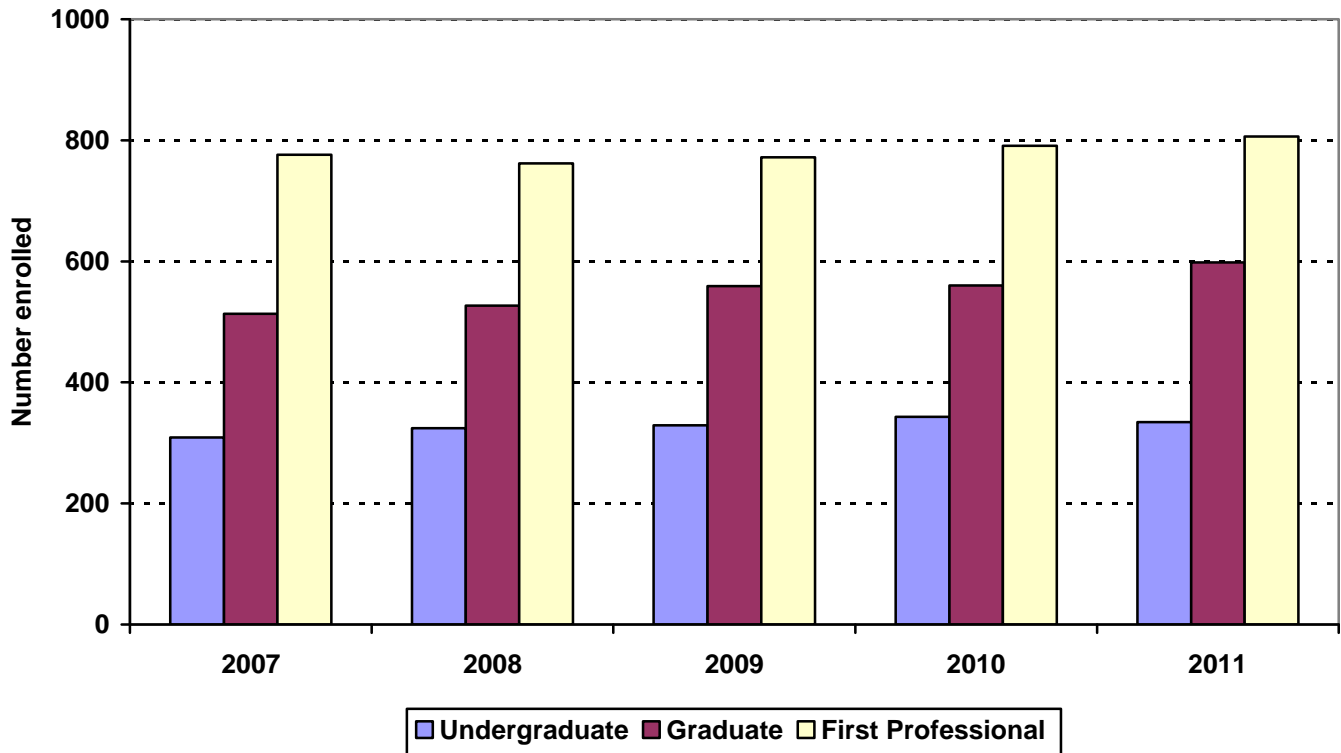

## Total Enrollment by Student Level Fall 2007 to Fall 2011

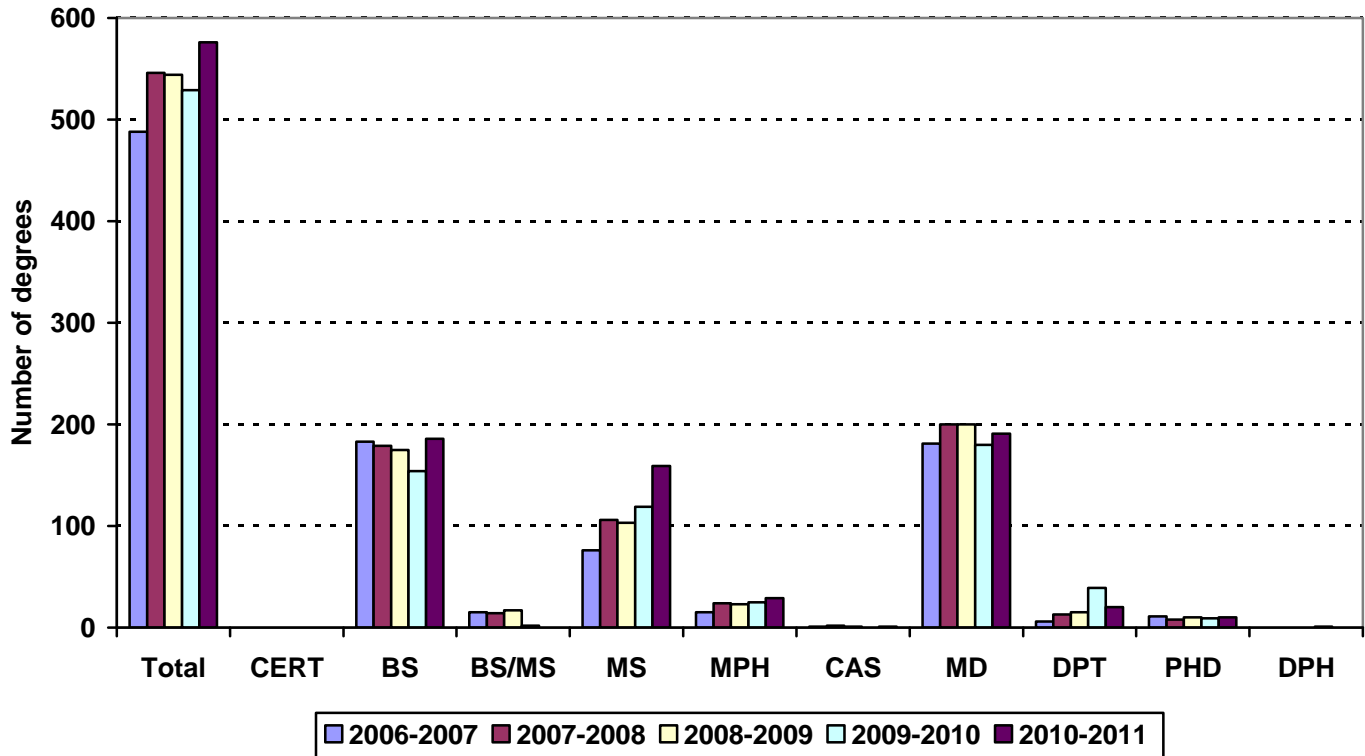
