Data for 1, 2, 5, and 10 years after graduation from Downstate is included. Please note that the number of completers will not match the total number of grads for this time frame for the following reasons:

- The table only includes graduates working in New York state for at least 3 quarters in the wage year and making at least the full time wage at the 2015 federal minimum wage (\$7.25 * 35 hours * 52 weeks = \$13,195) for the wage year.)
- Breakdowns of less than 10 and where one employer employs 80% or more of graduates are not shown.
- The data source is the NYS Unemployment Insurance system that covers almost all of the workforce but excludes most federal employees and the self-employed among other groups.
- Graduates employed in the fall or spring semester of the wage year are excluded from the data.
- The data only include the last, highest degree earned. If someone earned a BA degree then went on to earn a Master's degree, only the Mater's is included. We also exclude graduates who went on to earn another degree at another college after completing a degree at Downstate.

Additional Notes for Downstate Wage Data:

- Wages data are presented by the number of calendar years after graduation.
- The four most recent calendar years of SUNY graduate are combined. See the 'cohort years' tab for the degree years and wage years included.
- Only the most recent SUNY award of each graduate is included. Awards of graduates who went on to earn another degree at a non-SUNY school are not included.
- If a graduate earned two awards in the same calendar year, the highest degree is used. If a graduate completed two programs with the same award level in the same calendar year, both awards are included.
- Graduates who enrolled at a college during the fall or spring semester of the wage year are excluded.
- Wages percentiles are calculated using observations with at least three quarters of data for the year reported.
- Wages are displayed only when there are more than 10 graduates meeting the above wage criteria and when no employer employs 80% or more of the employees in the breakdown.
- All wages are adjusted for inflation to 2021 constant dollars using the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
- The NYS DOL does not distinguish between full and part-time employment. To account for this, wages that fall below the full-time federal minimum wage are excluded.
- Wage data only includes graduates employed in New York state.
- The source of the data is the New York state Unemployment Insurance system and includes over 95% of the New York workforce but does not include such groups as the self-employed and federal employees.
