Clinical Requirements for Graduation - Class of 2022

- Core Third Year Clerkships and Elective(s)
 - ✓ Trans. to Clerkships 1 week
 - ✓ Internal Medicine 8 wk
 - PC-I Primary Care/Family Medicine 4 wk
 - Surgery 8 wk
 - Anesthesiology 2wk

Clinical Requirements for Graduation - Class of 2022

- ✓ Pediatrics 6 weeks
- ✓ Women's Health 6 weeks
- ✓ Psychiatry 6 weeks
- Neurology 4 weeks
- ✓ Core Year Elective 2 weeks
- ✓ Gateway #3

Clinical Requirements for Graduation - Class of 2022


- > Advanced Clinical Year
 - Geriatrics/Palliative Care4 weeks
 - ✓ Subinternship 4 weeks
 - Medicine or Pediatrics
 - Subinternships in other specialties count as elective credit
 - Emerg Med Clerkship 4 wk
 - Any Core Clerkships not completed in Core Year must be completed immediately following Core Yr.

- Research Experience 4 weeks
- ✓ Critical Care 2 weeks
- ✓ Diag. Radiology 4 weeks
- ✓ **Electives** − 16 weeks
 - Check distribution requirements for subspecialties, research, and extramural electives
 - Students are permitted to do as many electives as their schedule will allow

Notes About Clinical Schedule

- Composed of four (4) 12-week blocks
 - Internal Medicine/Primary Care I
 - Surgery/Anesthesiology/Core Year Elective
 - Psychiatry/Neurology/Core Year Elective
 - Pediatrics/Women's Health
- Longitudinal Experience

Other Requirements

- Deadline to Take Step 1 March 27, 2019
 - All requests for a deadline extension due to extenuating circumstances must be made in advance in writing to Dean Christoforou
 - Must take Step 1 prior to starting rotations
- Must take Step 2 CK/CS by November 1 of senior year. Must pass both parts as graduation requirement.
- Must pass Gateway #3, a mandatory standardized patient experience scheduled during Core Year.

Clerkship Schedule Lottery

- Rank Your Preferences for Order of Clerkships
 - Must Rank all 4 tracks
 - Track 1 begins with Pediatrics/Women's Health
 - Track 2 begins with Psychiatry/Neurology
 - Track 3 begins with Medicine/Primary Care
 - Track 4 begins with Surgery/Anesthesiology

 - >You must rank all sites.


