It involves following one family planning a home birth through all prenatal visits, observing the birth, and following the family up to 6 weeks of the postpartum period. It must be taken for 3 semesters unless the family opts out of care or has care transferred to the hospital. Credits for these courses are not included in the number required for the Advanced Certificate.
