The credits for these courses are undergraduate level credits and are not included in the number required for the Advanced Certificate or Master’s Degree.

Either Health Care Policy Community Assessment, **NRMW 5403 or International Women’s Health Care Policy **NRMW 5302**, satisfies the requirement for the MS degree in Midwifery.

#A 1-3 credit independent study (NRMW 5700) may be taken as an elective in either or both of the first two summer semesters with faculty permission. Credits for these courses are not included in the number required for the Advanced Certificate or Master’s Degree.

##This elective must be taken for all 3 semesters. It involves following one family planning a home birth through all prenatal visits, observing the birth, and following the family up to 6 weeks of the postpartum period. It must be taken for 3 semesters unless the family opts out of care or has care transferred to the hospital. Credits for these courses are not included in the number required for the Advanced Certificate or Master’s Degree.
