ABOUT JOEL S. LEVINE, M.D. MEMORIAL LECTURESHIP



The Joel S. Levine, M.D. Memorial Lectureship was created in 2021 to honor Dr. Levine's memory. He had a diverse medical career, including clinical practice, health policy, advocacy, and improving healthcare access. Dr. Levine graduated from Stuyvesant High School and earned his medical degree from the State University of New York Downstate Medical Center, College of Medicine. Dr. Levine completed his

medical training at various institutions, including Tufts New England Medical Center and the University of Colorado School of Medicine.

Dr. Levine held significant roles in the medical community, including Chair Emeritus of the Board of Regents of the American College of Physicians (ACP). He played a crucial part in making colorectal cancer screening a Medicare benefit. Dr. Levine was a Professor of Medicine at the University of Colorado School of Medicine and Senior Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs for nearly two decades. Additionally, he led the Division of Digestive and Liver Health for a decade at Denver Health, Colorado's primary safety-net healthcare system.
