

Know your risk factors and get screened, especially if you're over 50.**

AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY SCREENING GUIDELINES

People who have no risk factors (other than age) should begin regular screenings at age 50 and have a colonoscopy every 10 years thereafter.

People who have a family history or other risk factors for colon or rectal cancer should begin their screening program at a younger age and have the tests done more frequently.
