Public Transportation

By subway, take either a **#2** or **#5** "Flatbush" train to the Winthrop Avenue stop. Exit on Nostrand and walk to Clarkson.

Walk east on Clarkson Avenue. The main entrance to the Outpatient Department and Suite R is **470 Clarkson Avenue**.

By bus, take the **B12 bus** and get off at the stop near East 37th Street on Clarkson Avenue—the stop is directly in front of University Hospital at Downstate. You can also take the **B44 bus** and get off at New York and Clarkson Avenues and walk to the entrance.

Parking

Parking is available in the nearby Kings County Hospital Center parking garage on Clarkson Avenue for a small fee.
