**An enriching summer program** that provides junior faculty with didactic courses in health disparities, diversity, community-based participatory research, study design, working with and presenting data, research ethics, grantsmanship skills, and academic career development.

### PROGRAM DETAILS

- Two-year training program, 2025-2026
- Summer 1: Two weeks
  - June 23rd to June 27th, 2025
- Summer 2: Summer 2026
- Research support up to \$15,000

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Underrepresented individuals in biomedical, clinical, behavioral, and social sciences. These groups include: Blacks or African Americans, Hispanics or Latinos, American Indians or Alaska Natives, Native Hawaiians and other Pacific Islanders, Individuals with disabilities, Individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds, and Women.

### PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Trainees will work with mentors throughout the year
- Development of NIH-style proposal and preliminary work
