



High School Students	TRANSPORT Brooklyn Health Promotion Center Health Advocates Mentorship Program (BHPC CHAMPS)	Research program that provides High School students with research experiences in basic science, public health, and neighborhood research.
Undergraduate Students	TRANSPORT SPRINTER	Research program that provides undergraduate students with research experiences in basic science, public health, and neighborhood-based research.
Medical Students	TRANSPORT Program to Accelerate Academic Careers in Research (PACERS)	Research Program that addresses the urgent need to prepare investigators for health research.
Graduate Students	TRANSPORT Transitions to Academic Careers (TRACS)	Research Program that provides students in MD, DrPH, DNP programs with an intensive research experience that prepares them for competitive residency or post-doctoral positions.
Post Doctoral Fellows	TRANSPORT Post-Doctoral Fellows	Research plans closely tied to mentor and developed post-selection while in training, minor project budget.
Junior Faculty Program	TRANSPORT Junior Faculty	Research plans developed post-selection while in training, minor project budget.
Advanced Postdoctoral Fellows and Junior Faculty	TRANSPORT	Research program that recruits 3 new full-time scientists over 5 years who will bring additional expertise in social science, population health, implementation science research and expand network of mentors for trainees.
Collaborative Science Cafes	TRANSPORT	Research forum for implementing a new 16-week research training program where collaborative partners receive structured training on principles of neighborhood research, grant writing workshops, and learn about open research studies.
