- One-year training program, 2025-2026
- Summer 1: Two weeks
 - o June 16th to June 27th, 2025
- Summer 2: NIH Mock Study Section, Summer 2026
- Research support up to \$15,000

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Program is open to all Junior faculty at the Assistant Professor level.
- Applicants from underrepresented backgrounds are encouraged to apply.
- Underrepresented individuals in biomedical, clinical, behavioral, and social sciences include: Blacks or African Americans, Hispanics or Latinos, American Indians or Alaska Natives, Native Hawaiians and other Pacific Islanders, Individuals with disabilities, Individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds, and Women.
